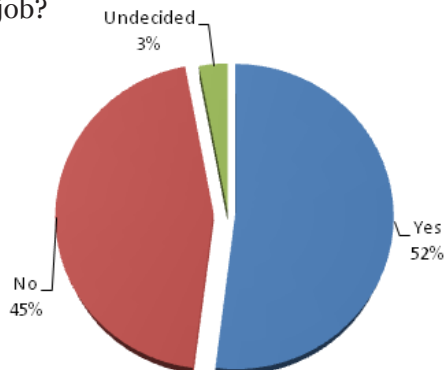

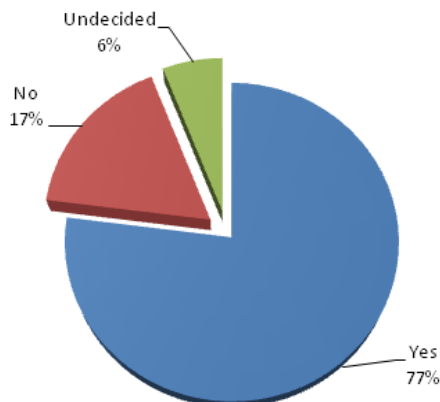
3. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



4. Do you think that we need to reduce the sentences or seek alternative sentencing for non-violent criminal offenders due to the fact that we have limited space in our prisons?

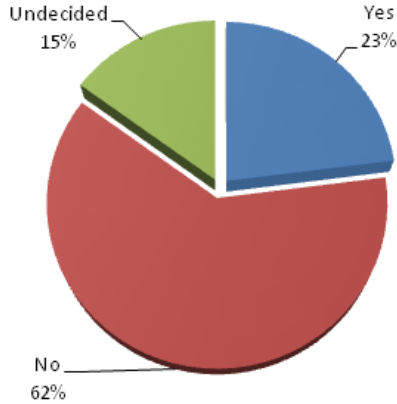


5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?

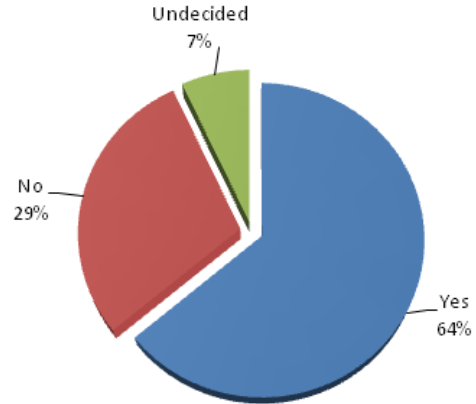

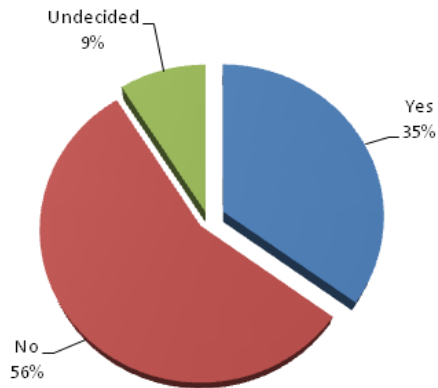
6. Would you support a local option tax increase to fund mass transit, such as a commuter bus or light rail system?



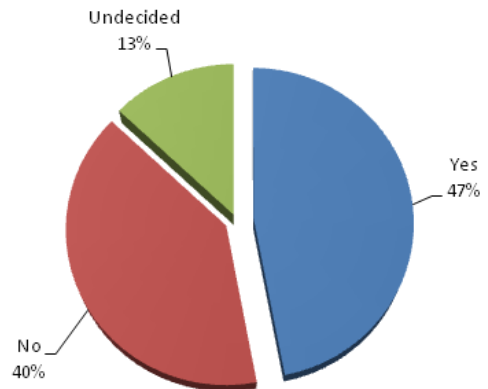
7. Do you support a statewide smoking ban in buildings accessible by the public?



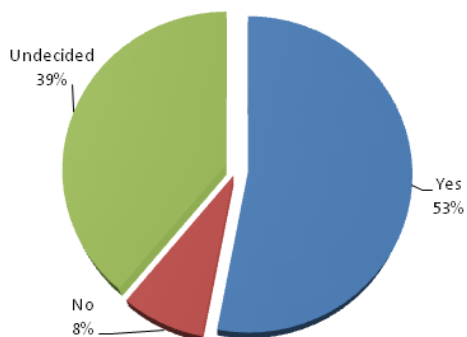
8. Would you support making pseudophedrine (common ingredient in cold medicine which is also used in the production of Meth) available only by prescription?
