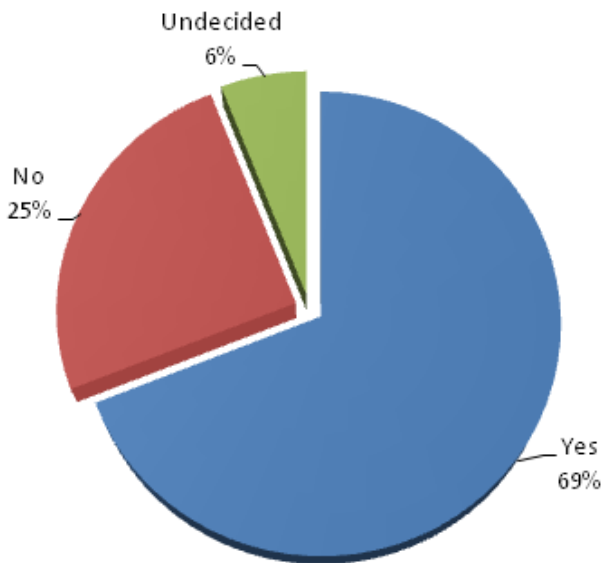




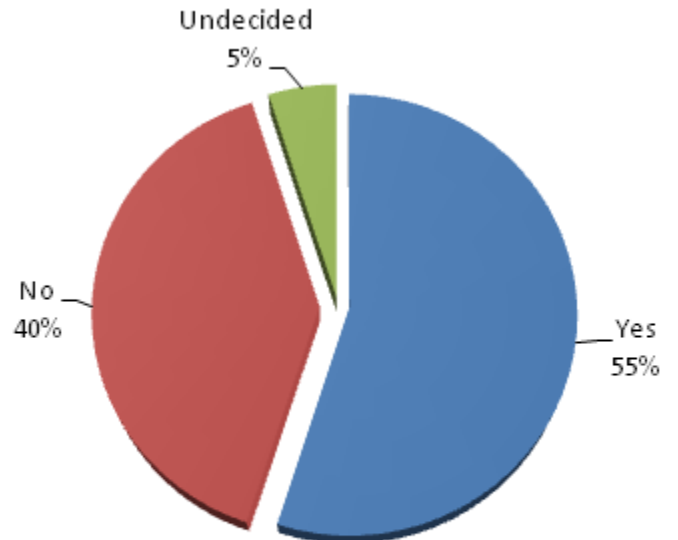

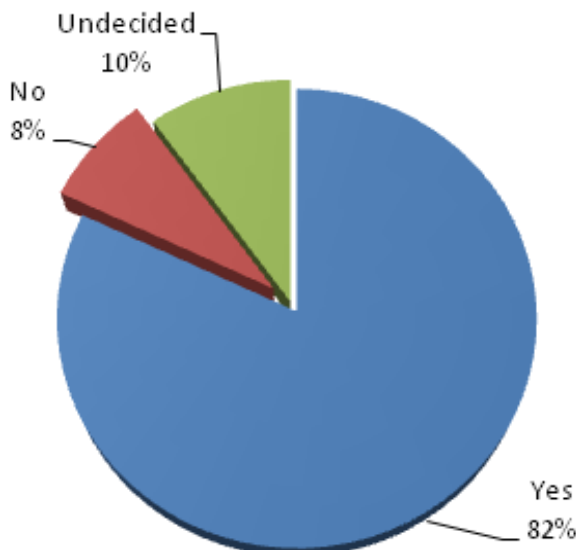
1. Do you believe reducing government regulation is as important as reducing government spending in improving the economy?



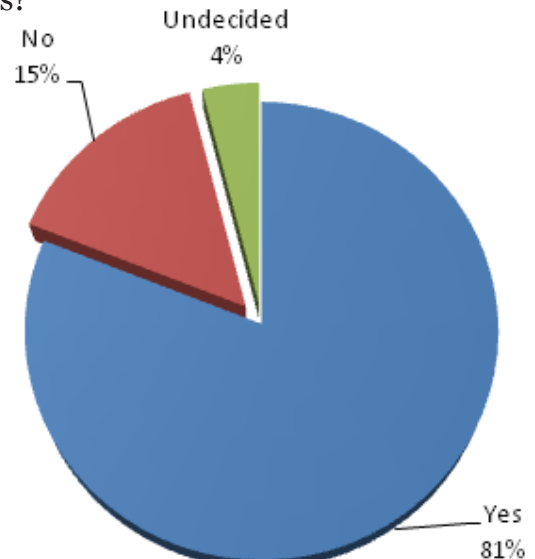
2. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



3. Do you support allowing voters to decide whether or not to eliminate their township government?

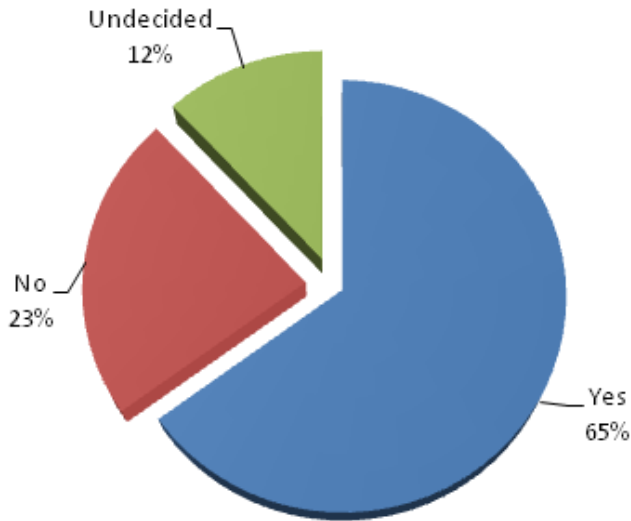


4. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?

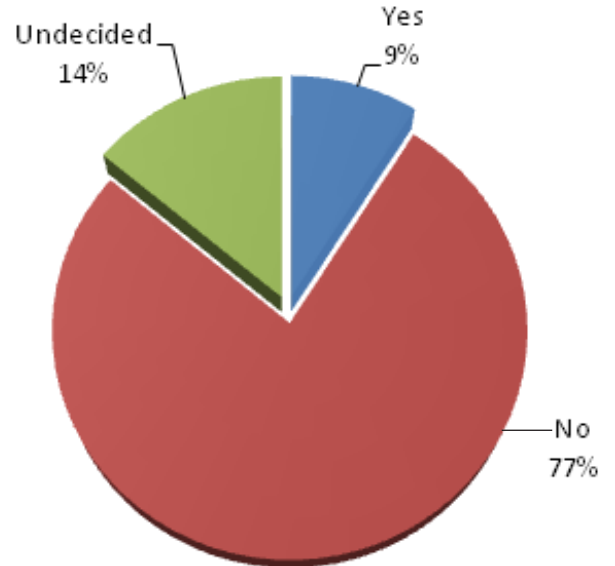

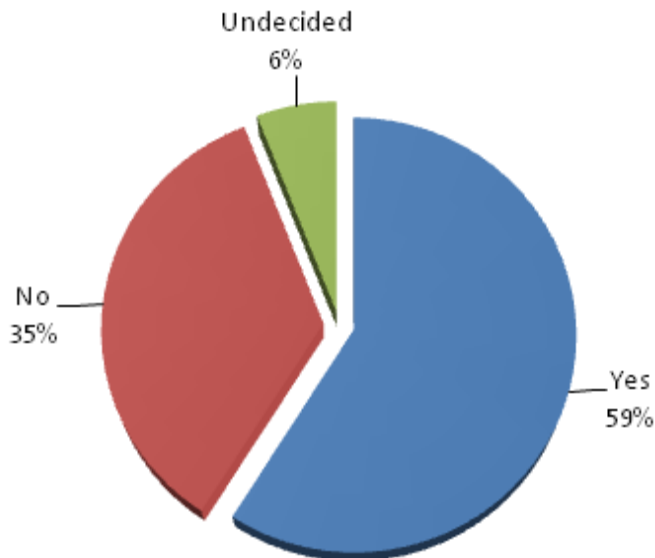
5. Overall, would you say that Indiana has done a better job of managing its finances than most other states?



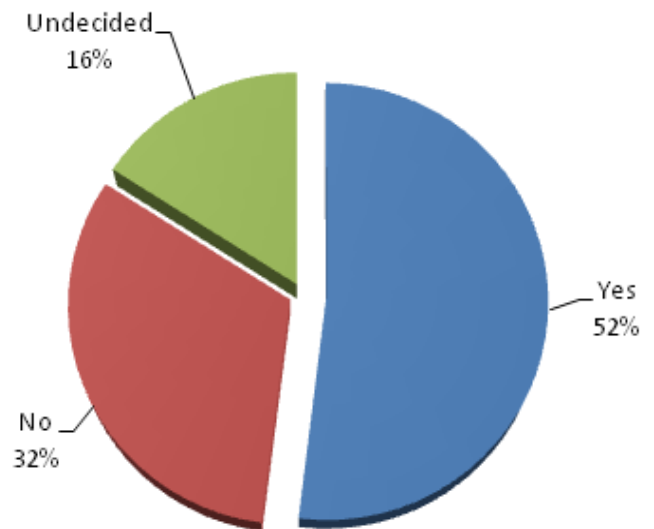
6. Do you think there are high quality job opportunities for recent college graduates in your community?
