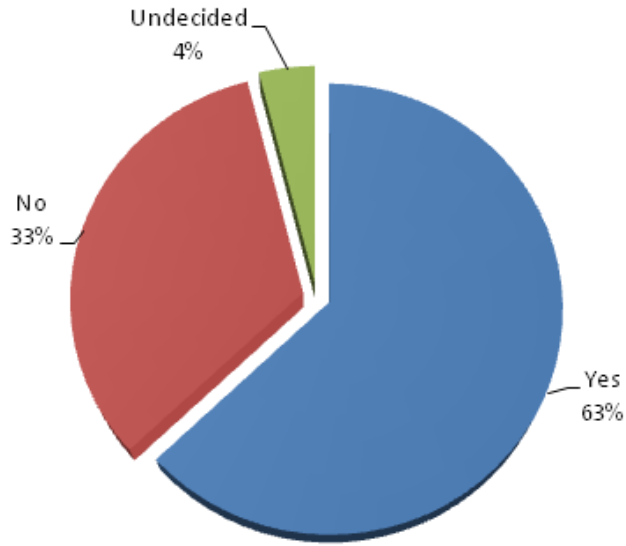




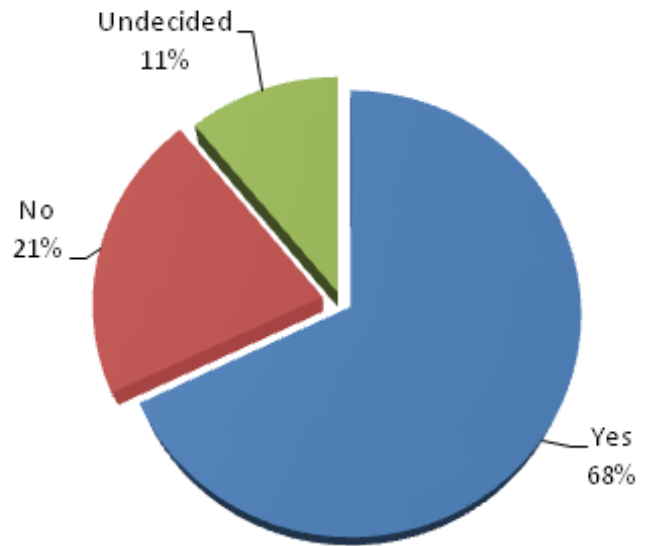

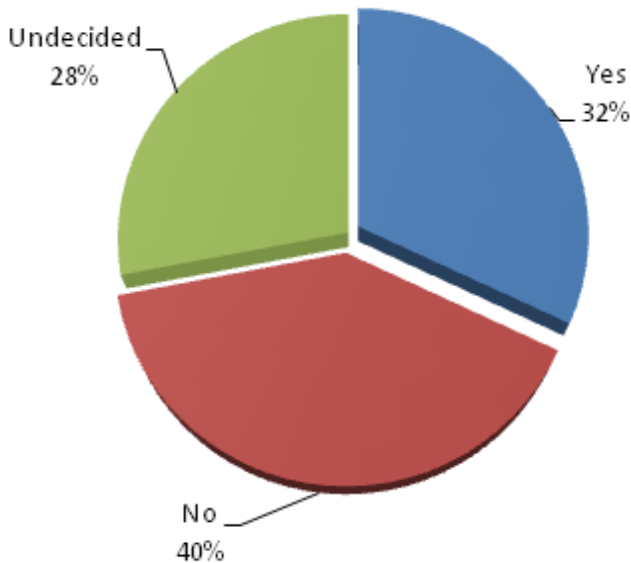
1. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



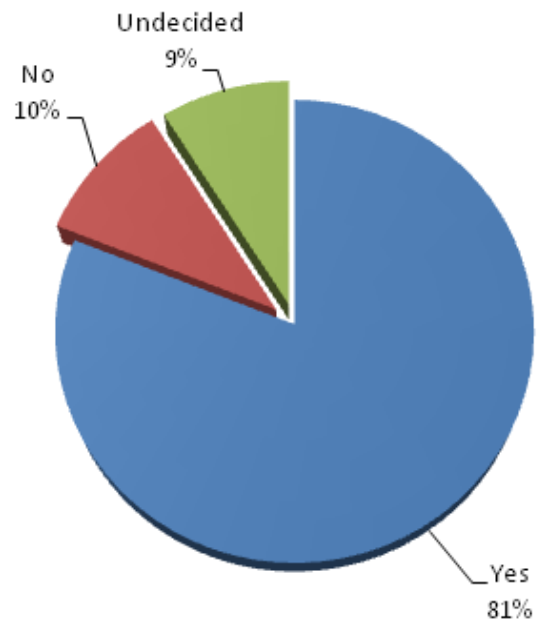
2. Do you believe that a driver's license, registration and insurance should be required of people who operate mopeds on public roadways?



3. Do you support eliminating township boards and transferring their fiscal authority to the county?

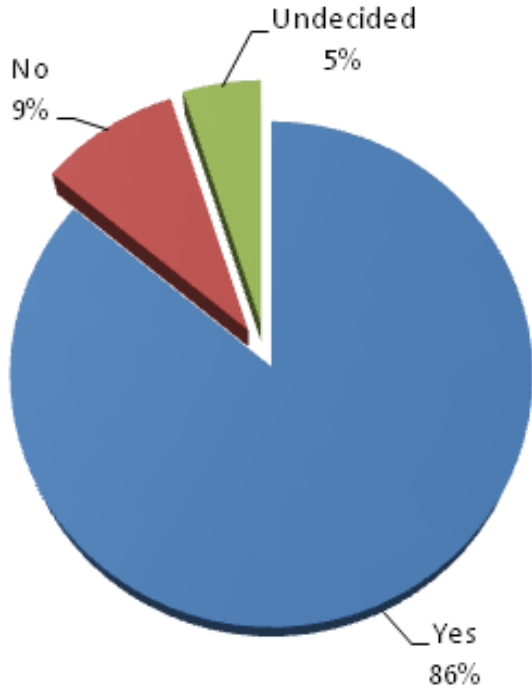


4. Do you support allowing voters to decide whether or not to eliminate their township government?

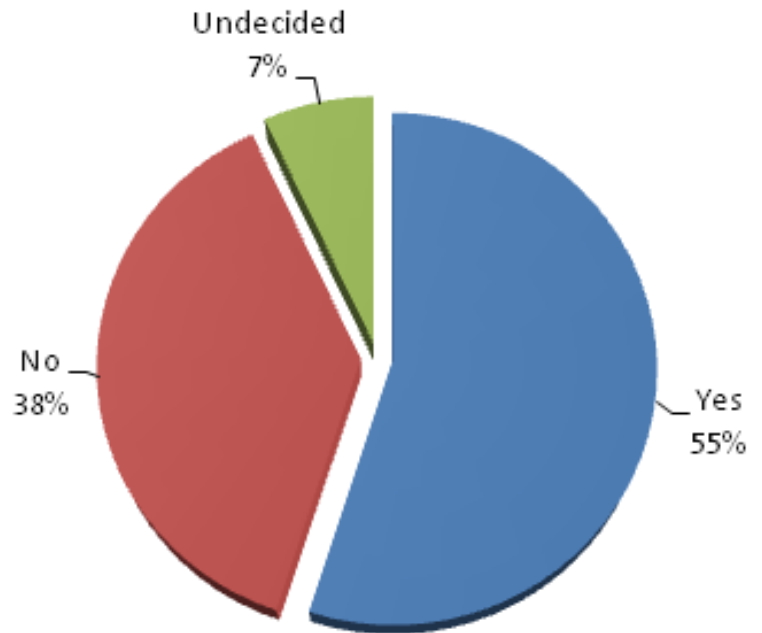

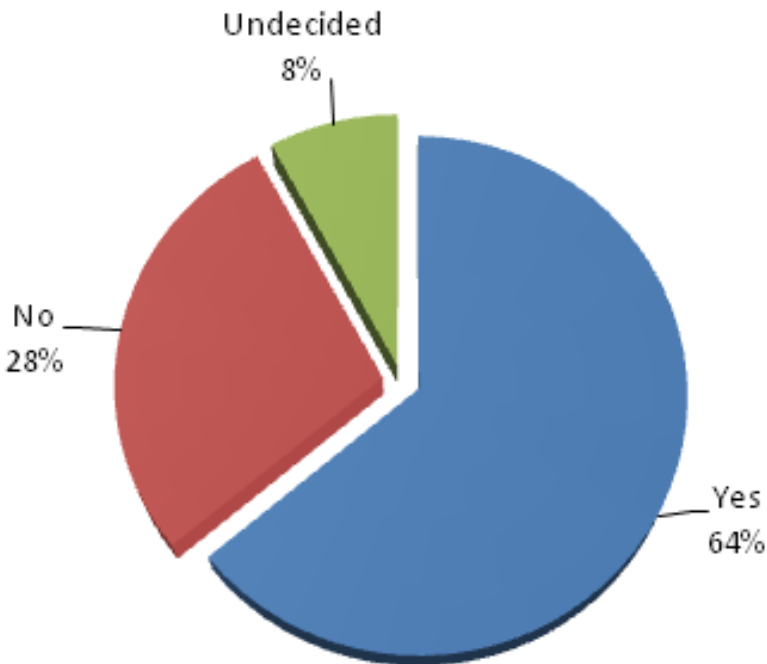
5. Do you believe Indiana, like other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receive state-funded welfare benefits?
