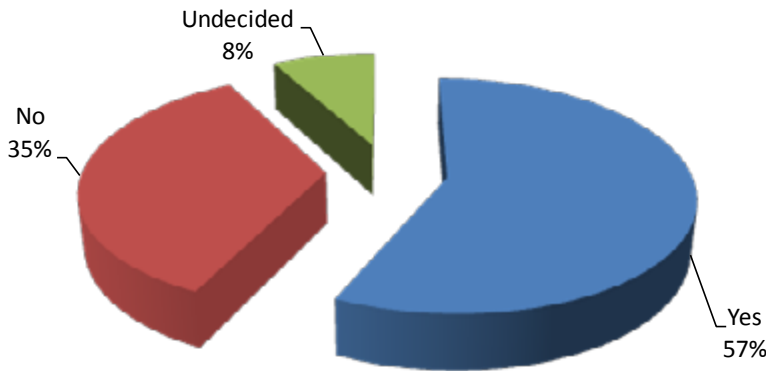




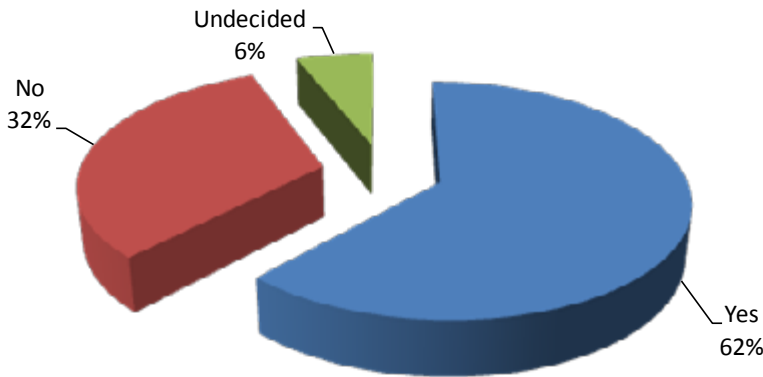

## 2011 Pre-Session Survey Results

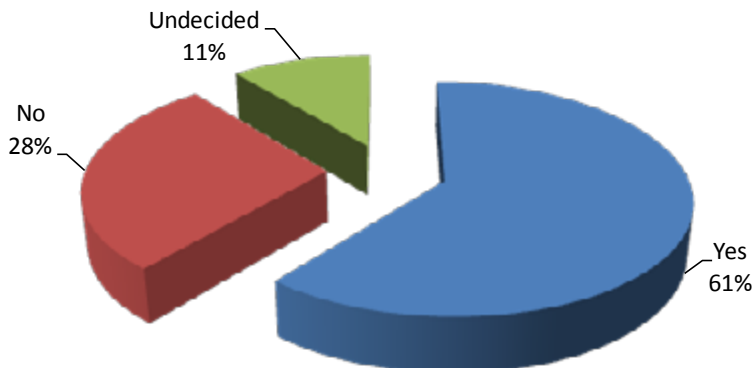
Do you think that a student's improvement should be one factor in a teacher's pay?

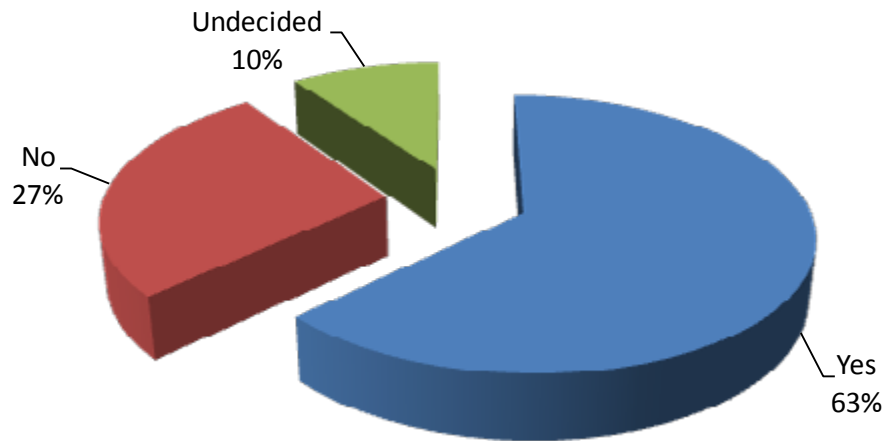

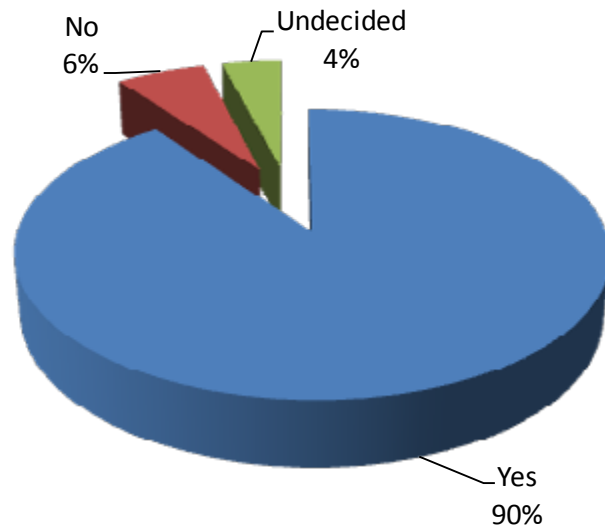
