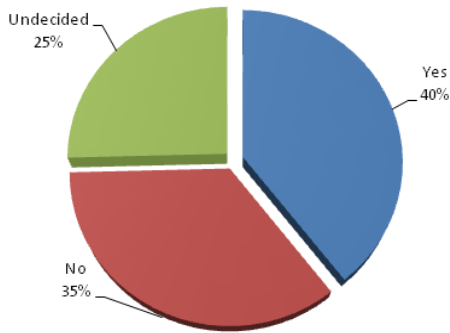




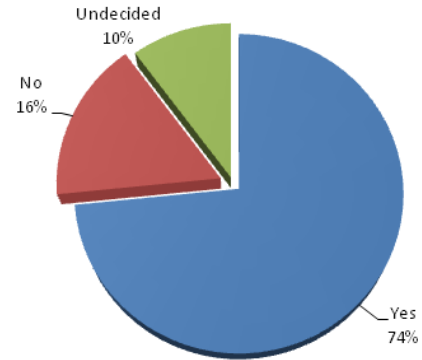

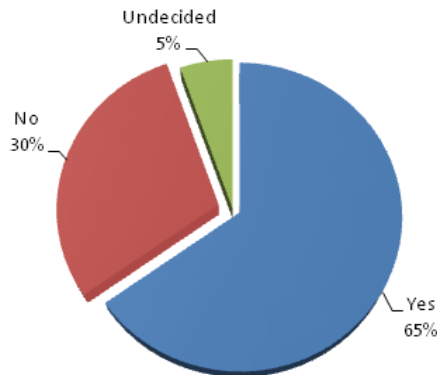
1. Do you believe that Indiana's economy is in better shape today than a year ago?



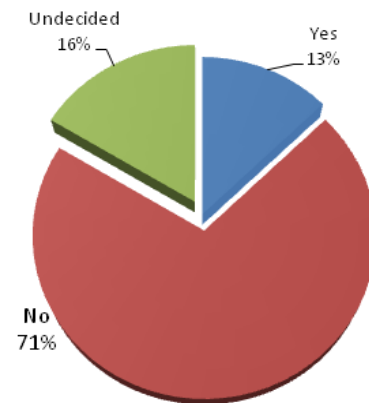
2. Do you believe reducing government regulation is a bigger factor in improving the economy rather than increasing government spending?



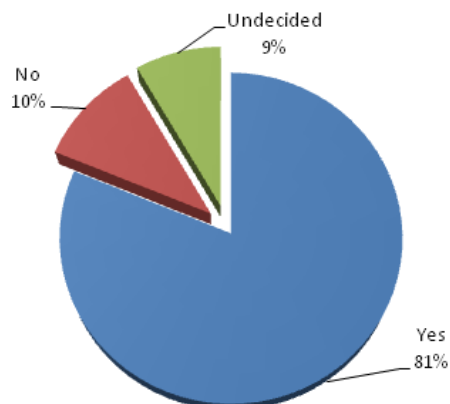
3. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



4. Do you believe that there is enough transparency with your local government and local schools?

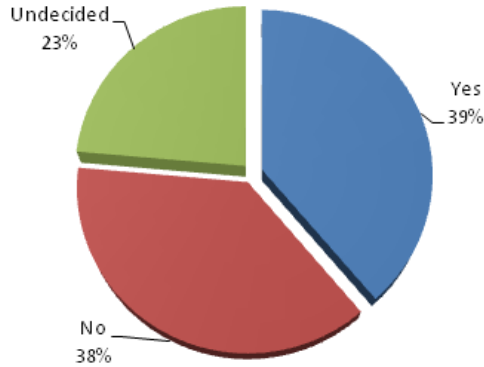


5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?

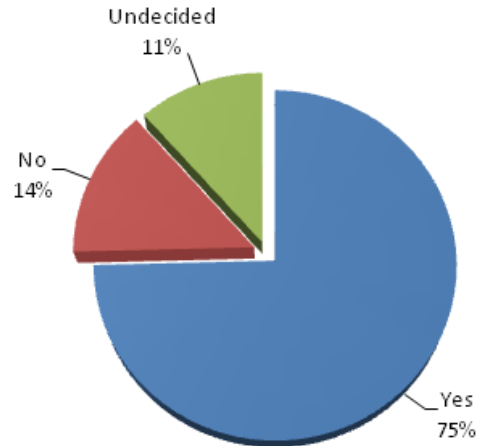

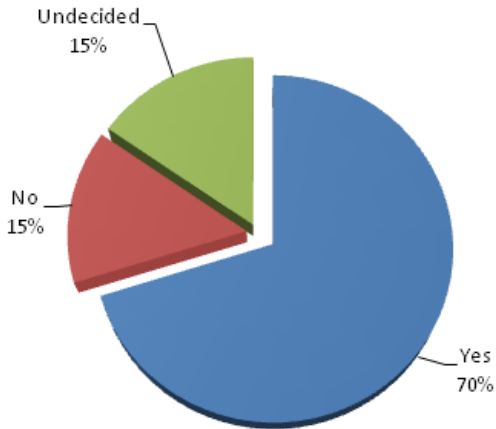
6. Do you think that we need to reduce the sentences for non-violent criminal offenders due to the fact that we have limited space in our prisons?



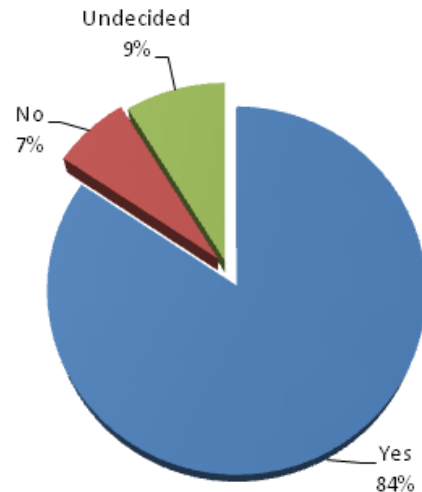
7. Overall, would you say that Indiana has done a better job of managing its finances than most other states?



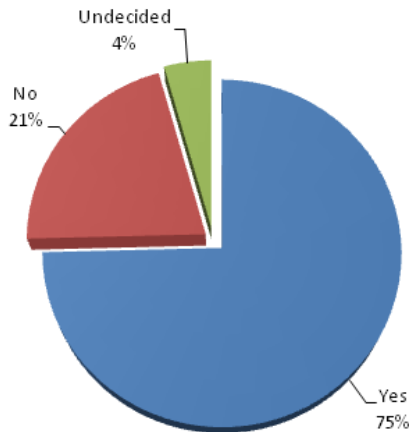
8. Do you believe that providing tax incentives to new and expanding businesses is a good strategy for increasing employment opportunities available to Hoosier workers?
