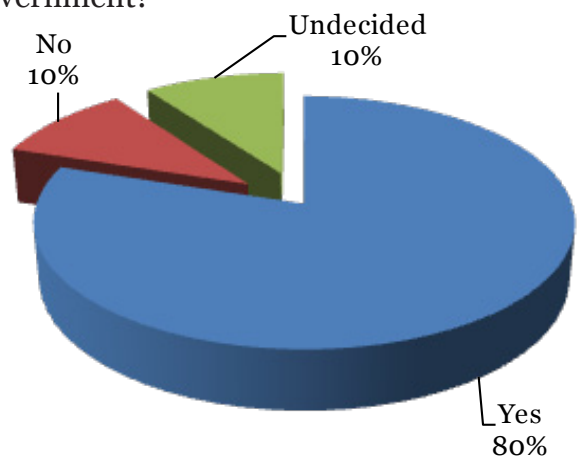
2. Do you believe that Indiana's economy is in better shape today than a year ago?



3. Do you believe that there is enough transparency with your local government and local schools?

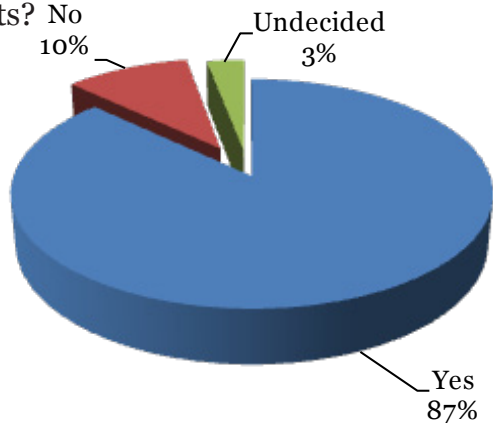

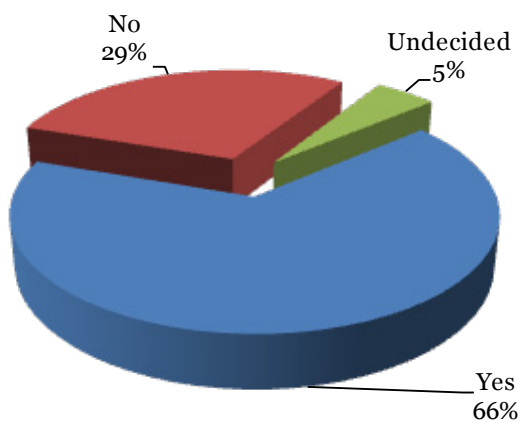
7. Do you believe that homeschooled children should have the ability to participate in school athletics offered within their local public school system?
