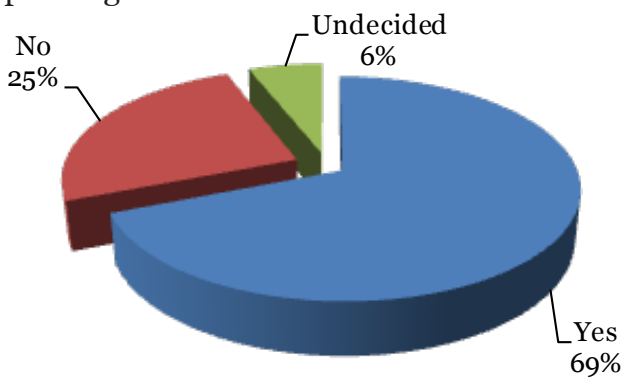
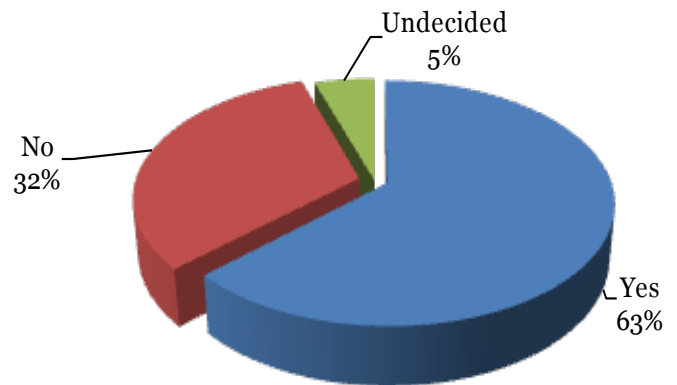




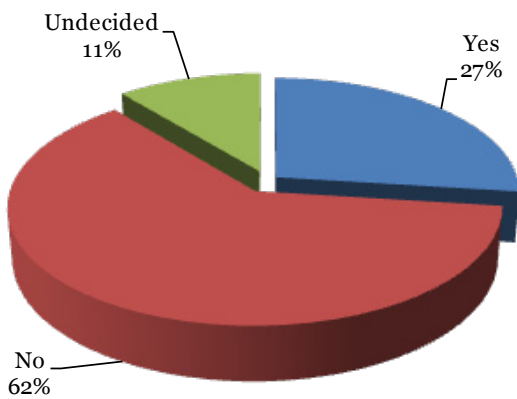
1. Do you believe reducing government regulation is a bigger factor in improving the economy rather than increasing government spending?



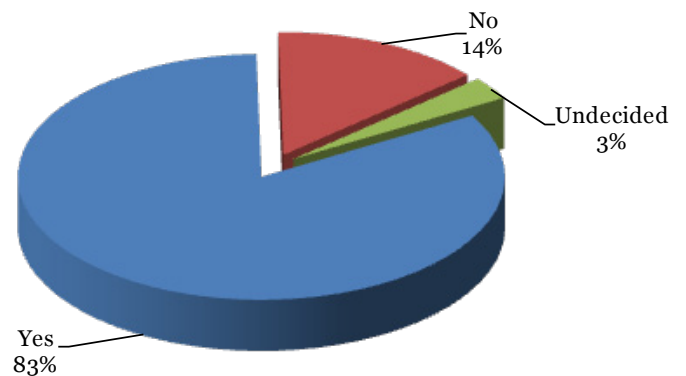
2. Would you support a right to work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



3. Would you support a local option tax increase to fund mass transit, such as a commuter bus or light rail system?

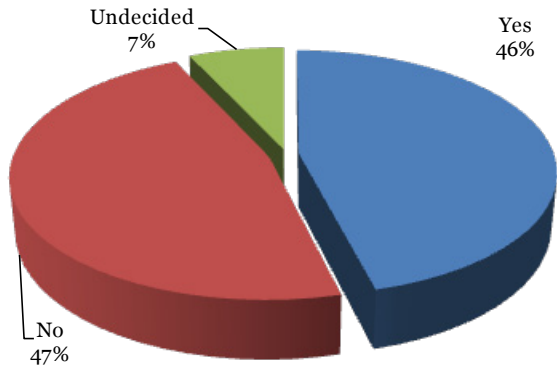


4. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?

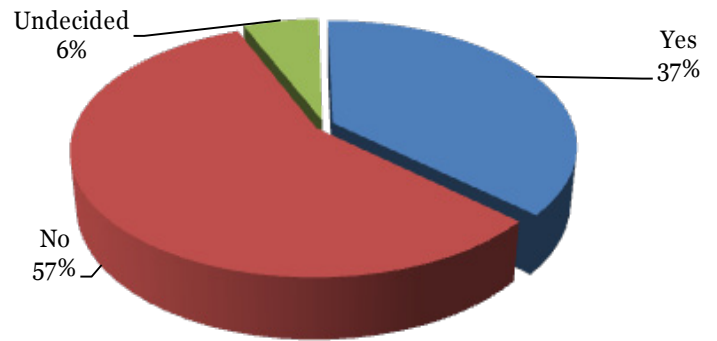

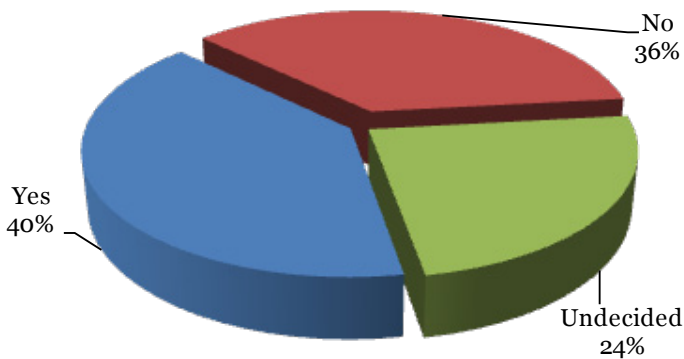
5. Do you support a statewide smoking ban?



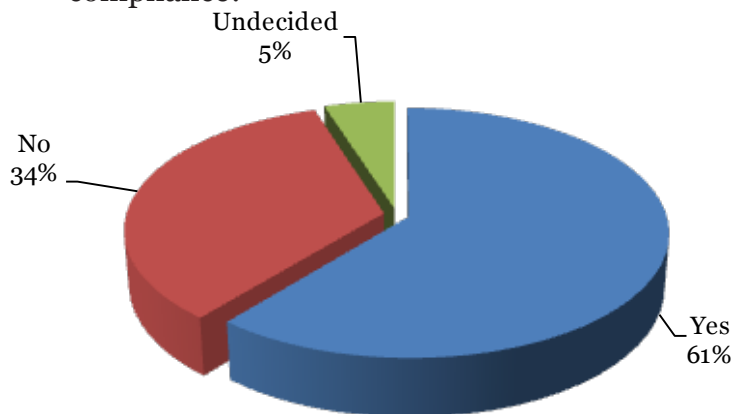
6. Would you support making pseudoephedrine (common ingredient in cold medicine which is also used in the production of Meth) available only by prescription?
