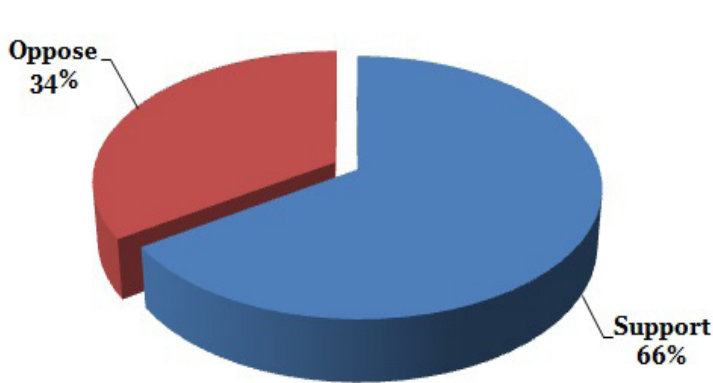


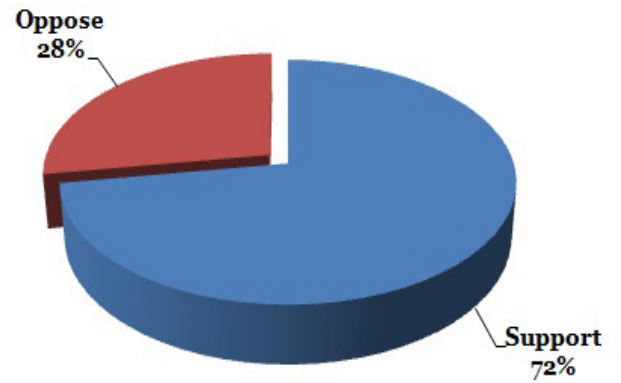

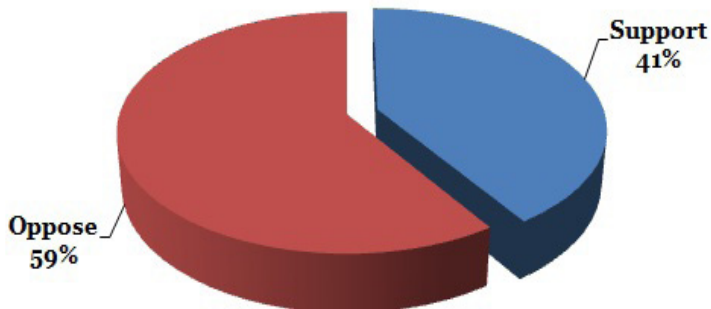
1. Do you support or oppose that a driver's license, registration and insurance should be required of people who operate mopeds on public roadways?



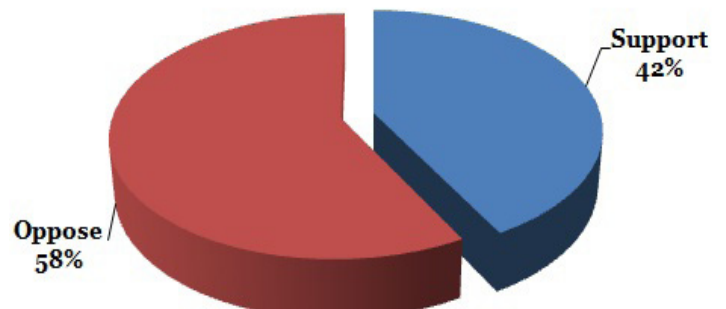
2. Do you support or oppose prohibiting local government officials from hiring his/her family member?



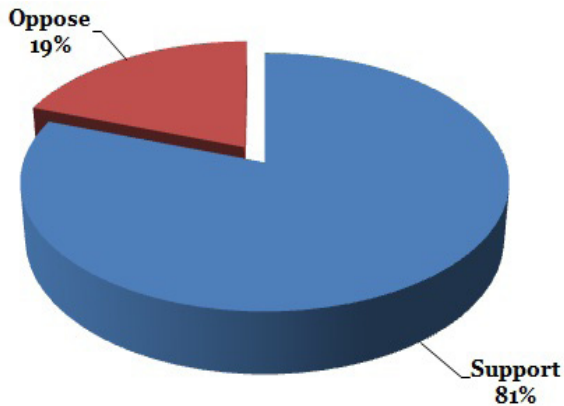
3. Do you support or oppose the elimination of township government?



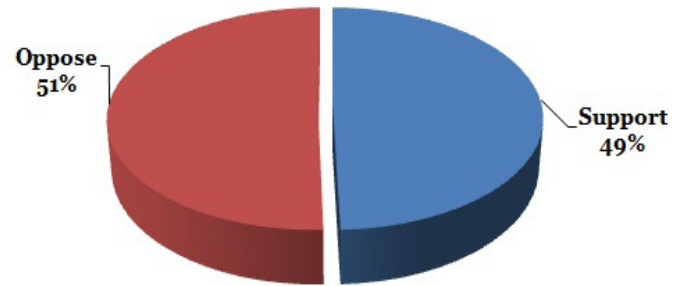
4. Do you support or oppose eliminating township boards and transferring their fiscal authority to the county?



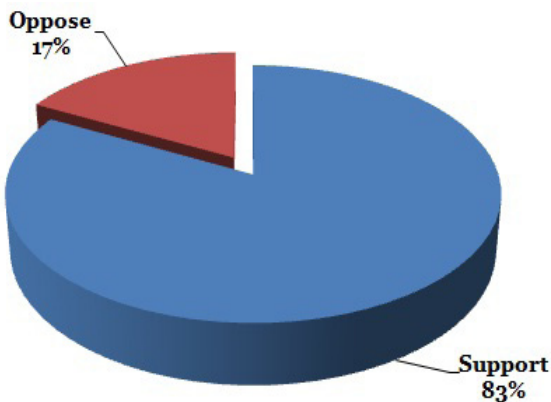
5. Do you support or oppose implementing random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?



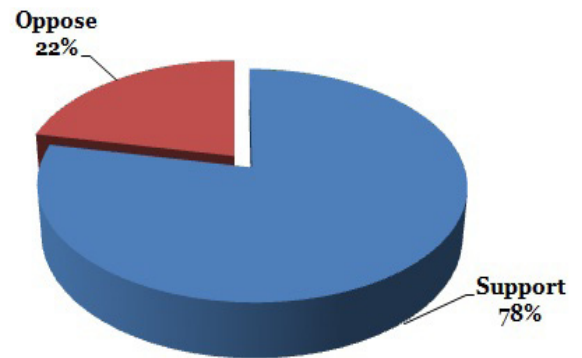
6. Do you support or oppose making pseudoephedrine (common ingredient in cold medicine which is also used in the production of Meth) available only by prescription?



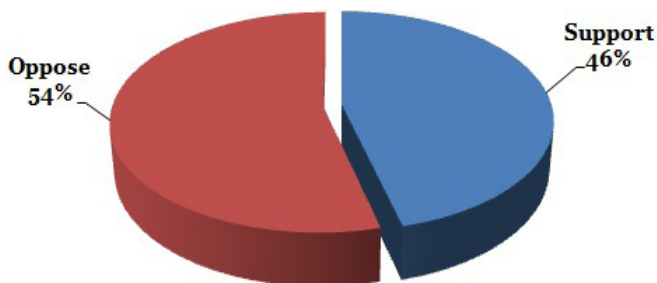
7. Do you support or oppose non-violent drug users being treated in a community rehab center rather than serving time in jail?
