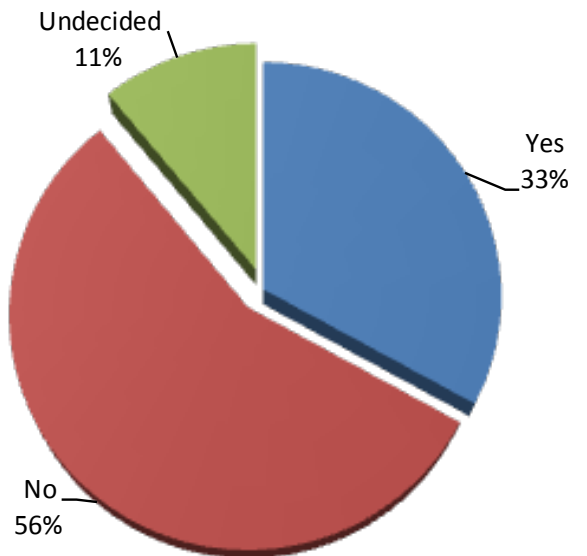
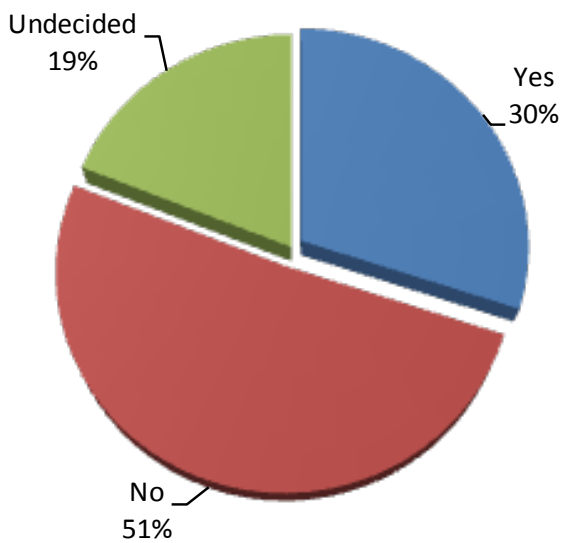
1. Am I keeping you well informed about state and local news in our district?

2. The state instituted a transparency portal (<http://www.in.gov/itp>) with financial information for the state and local governments. Do you feel this information is easily accessible?

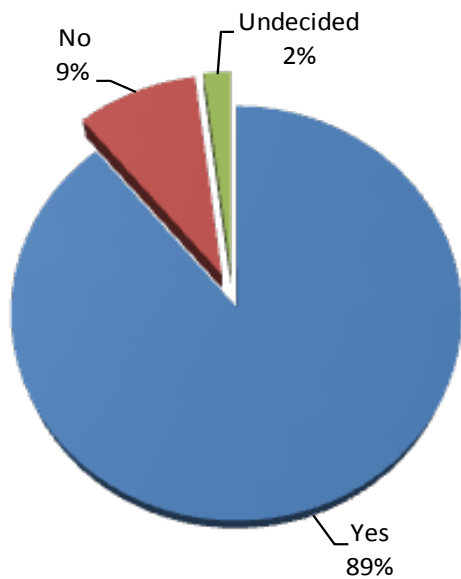


3. Do you believe that there is enough transparency with your local government and local schools?

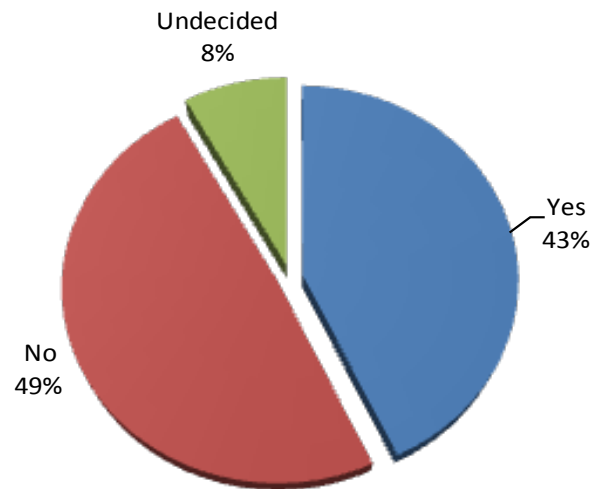
4. Do you support the elimination of township government?



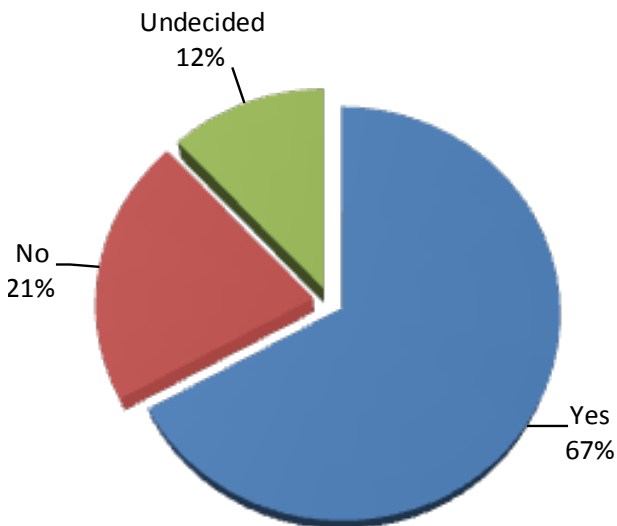
5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?



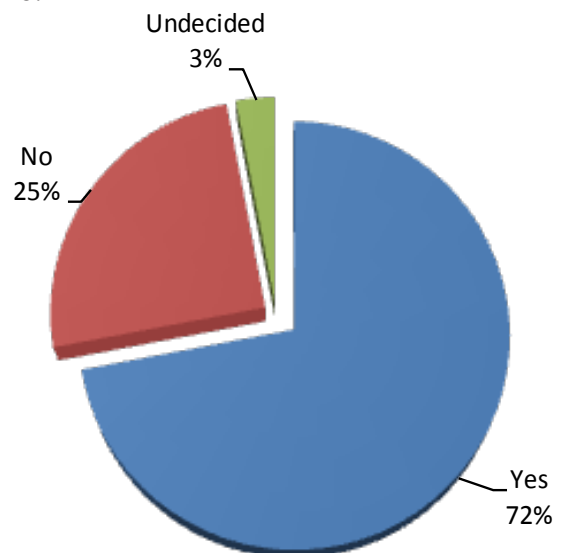
6. Would you support making pseudoephedrine (common ingredient in cold medicine which is also used in the production of Meth) available only by prescription?
