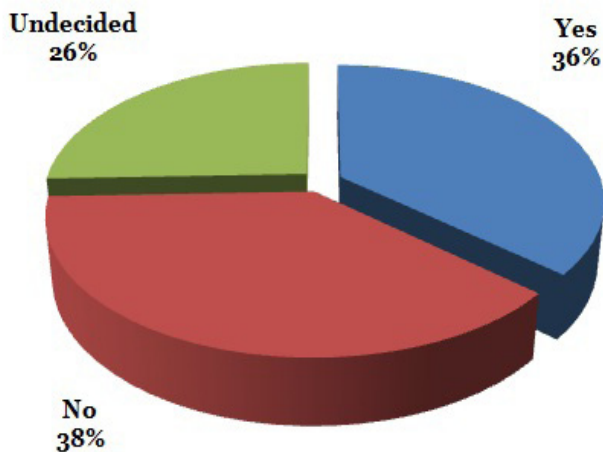


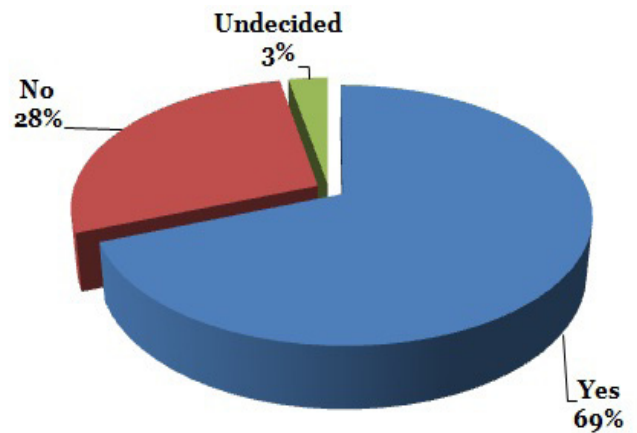


# 2012 Session Survey Results

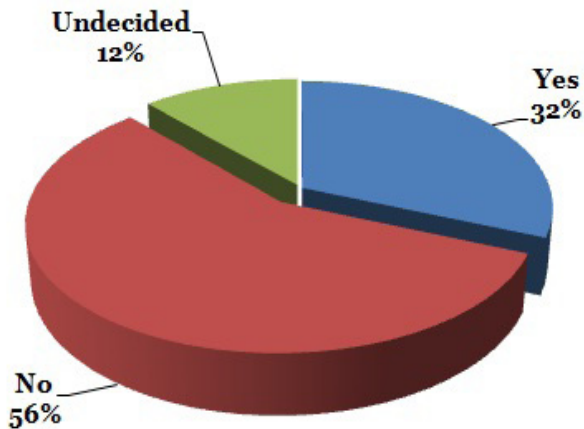
1. Do you believe that Indiana's economy is in better shape today than a year ago?



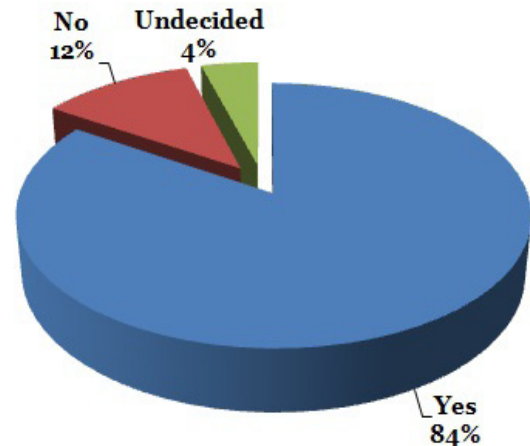
2. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



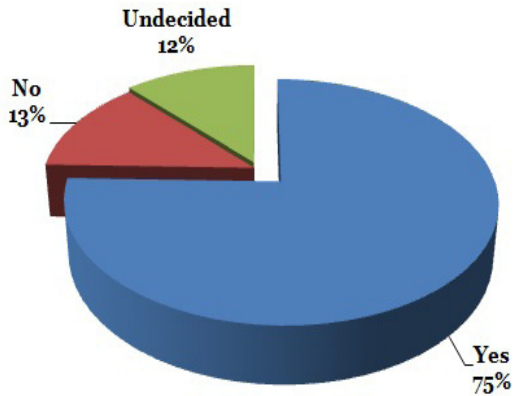
3. Would you support a local option tax increase to fund mass transit, such as a commuter bus or light rail system?



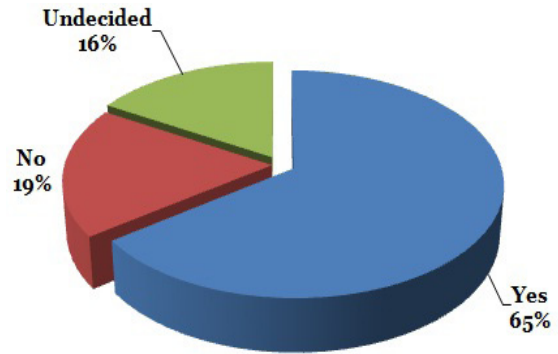
4. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?



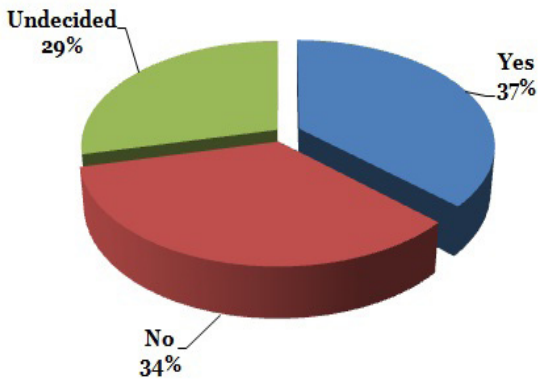
5. Overall, would you say that Indiana has done a better job of managing its finances than most other states?



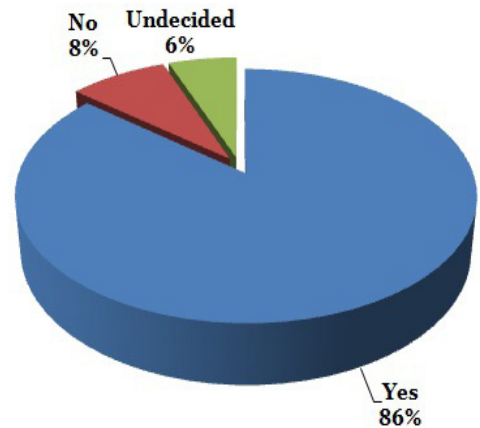
6. Do you believe that providing tax incentives to new and expanding businesses is a good strategy for increasing employment opportunities available to Hoosier workers?



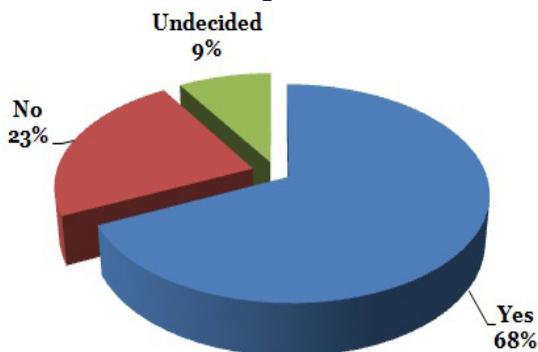
7. Do you believe that our state universities are doing a good job preparing students for today's ever changing workforce?
