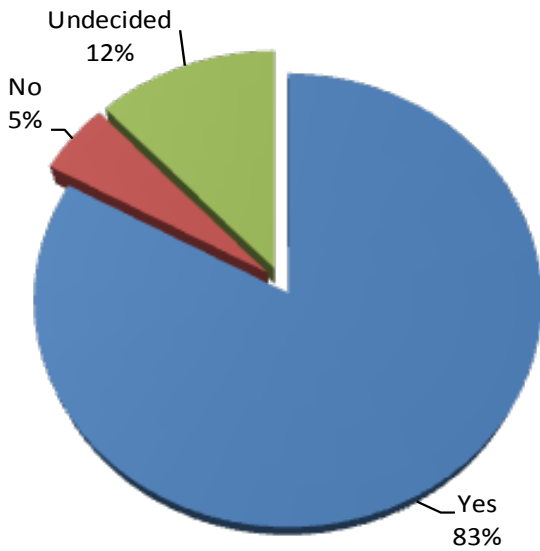


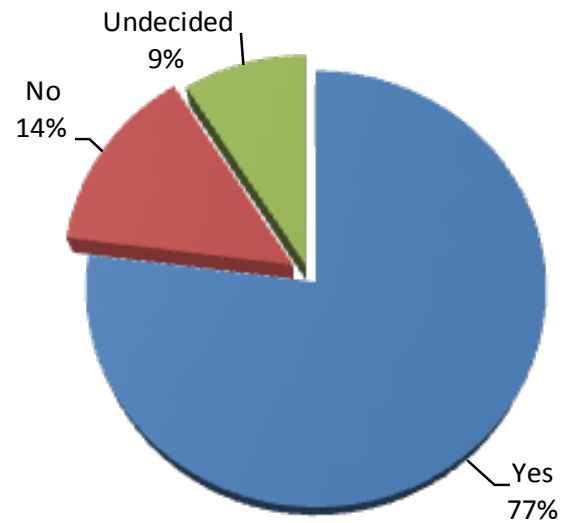

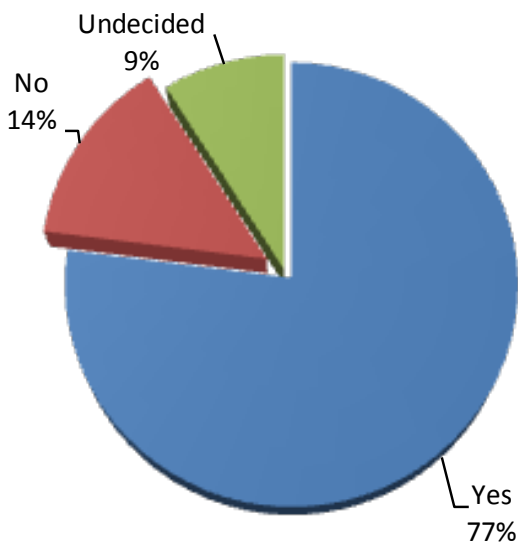
1. Am I keeping you well informed about state and local news in our district?



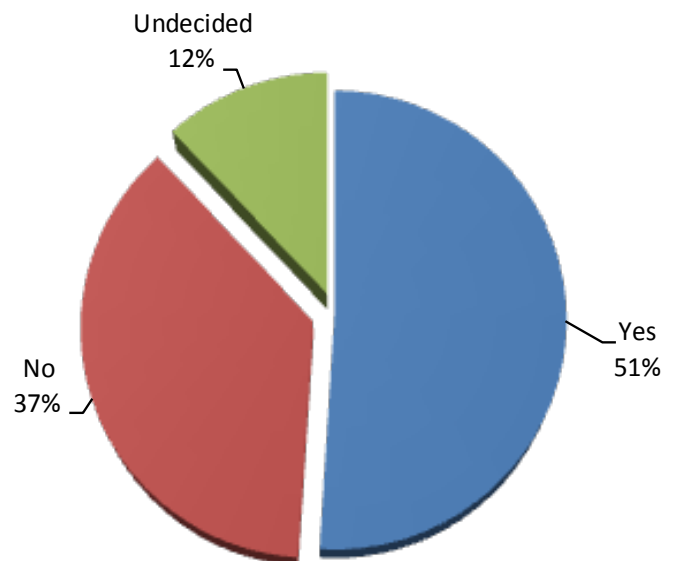
2. Do you believe reducing government regulation is a bigger factor in improving the economy rather than increasing government spending?



3. Do you support prohibiting local government officials from hiring his/her family member?

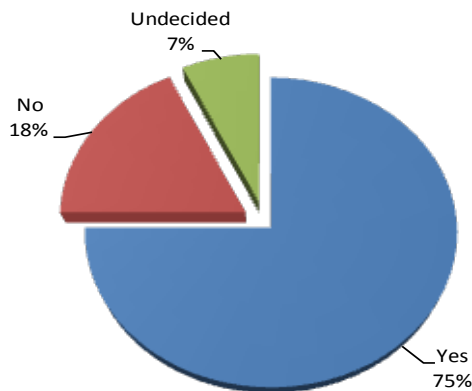


4. Do you support the elimination of township government?

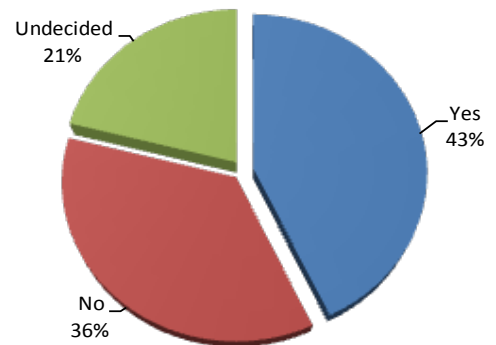

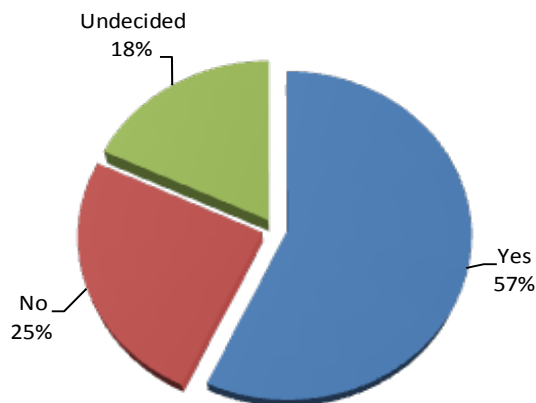
5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?



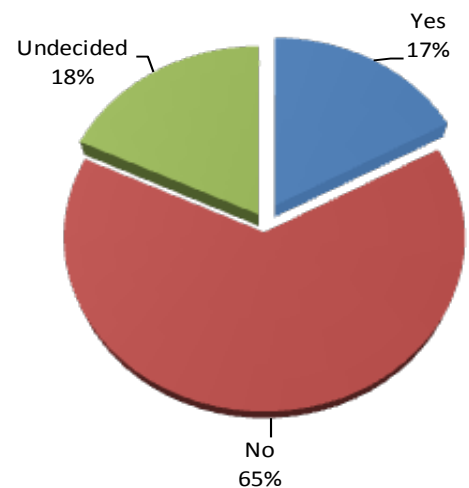
6. Do you think that we need to reduce the sentences for non-violent criminal offenders due to the fact that we have limited space in our prisons?



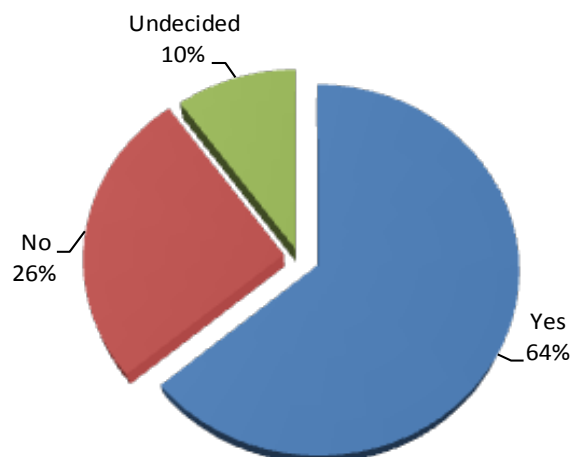
7. Do you think that non-violent drug users should be treated in a community rehab center rather than serving time in jail?
