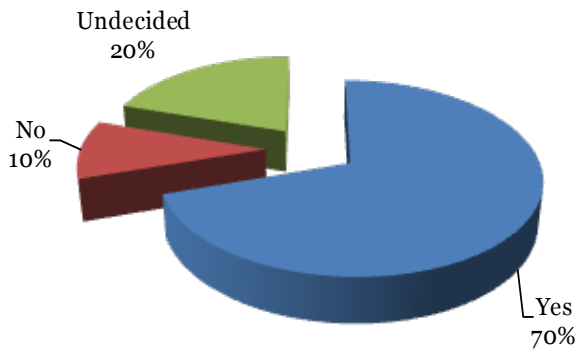
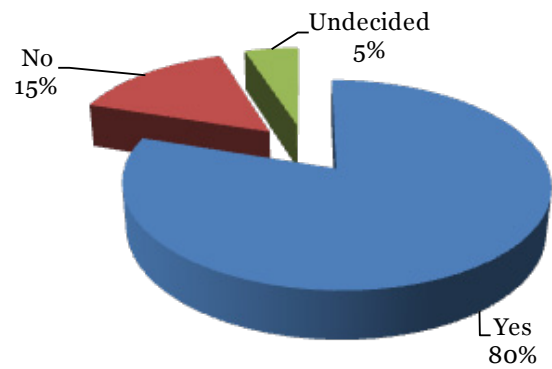




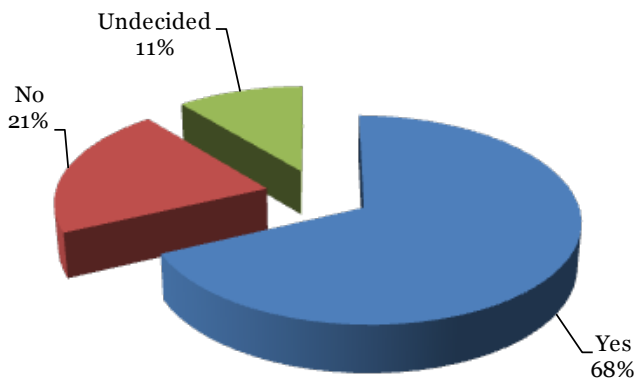
1. Am I keeping you well informed about state and local news in the district?



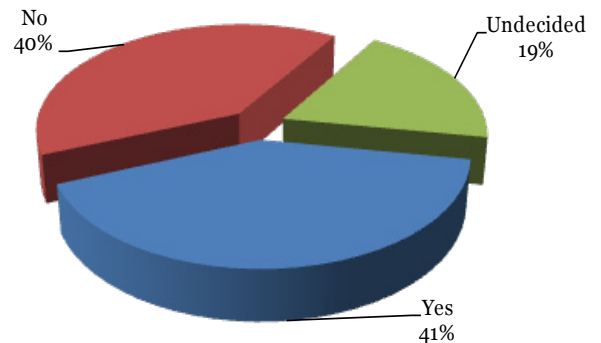
2. Would you support a right to work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?



3. Do you believe that a driver's license, registration and insurance should be required of people who operate mopeds on public roadways?

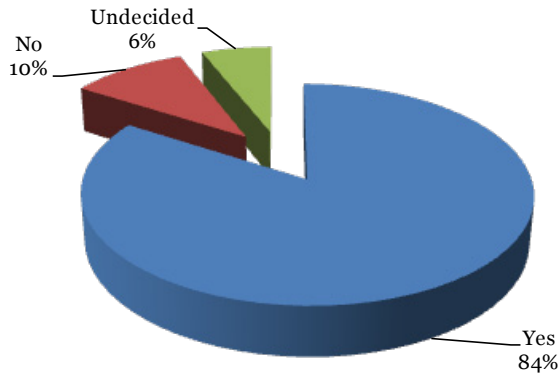


4. Would you support a local option tax increase to fund mass transit, such as a commuter bus or light rail system?

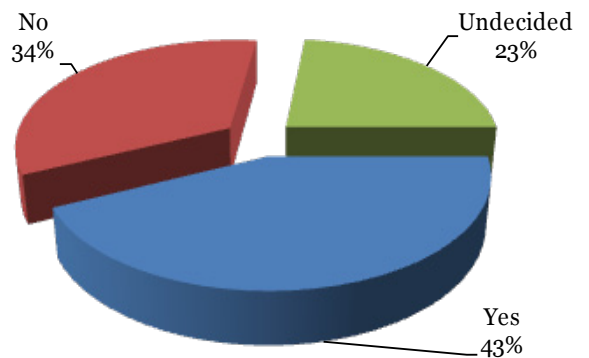

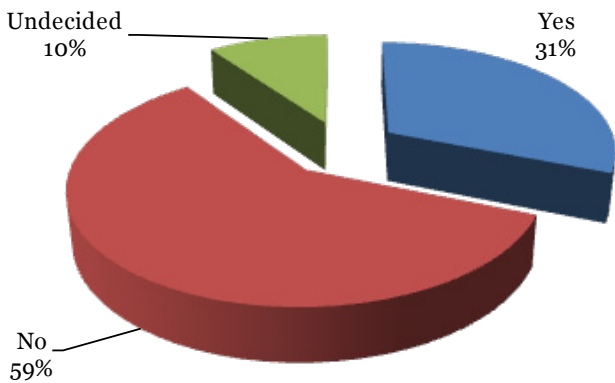
5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?



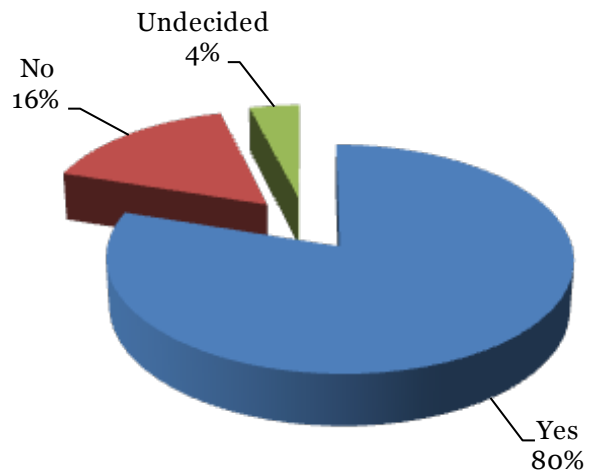
6. Do you think we need to reduce the sentences for non-violent criminal offenders due to the fact that we have limited space in our prisons?
