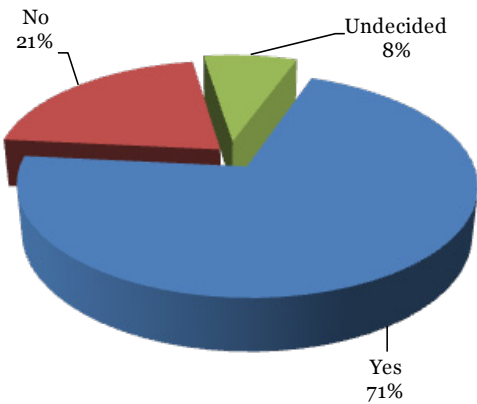
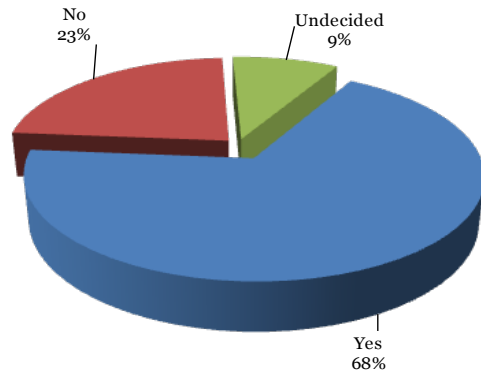




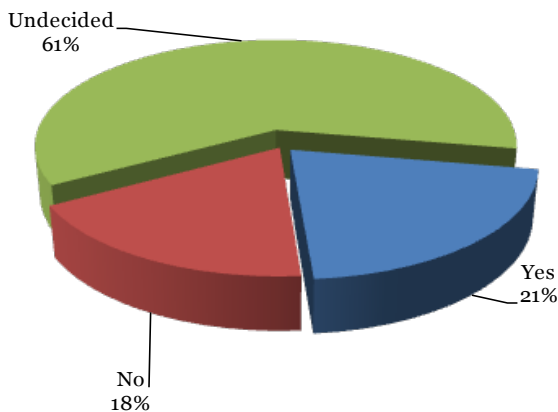
1. Do you believe reducing government regulation is a bigger factor in improving the economy rather than increasing government spending?



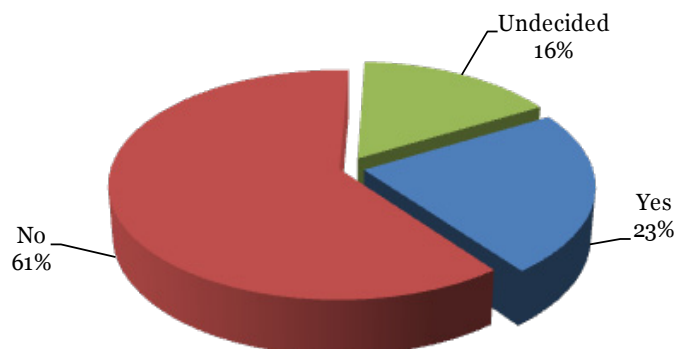
2. Do you believe that a driver's license, registration and insurance should be required of people who operate mopeds on public roadways?



3. The state instituted a transparency portal (<http://www.in.gov/itp>) with financial information for the state and local governments. Do you feel this information is easily accessible?

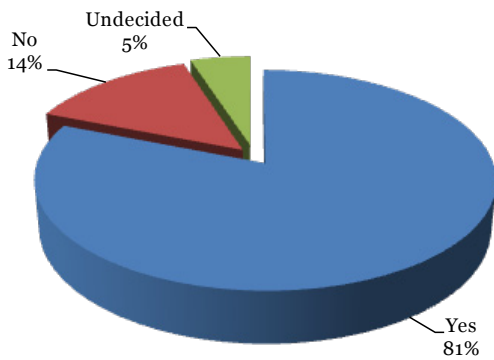


4. Do you believe that there is enough transparency with your local government and local schools?

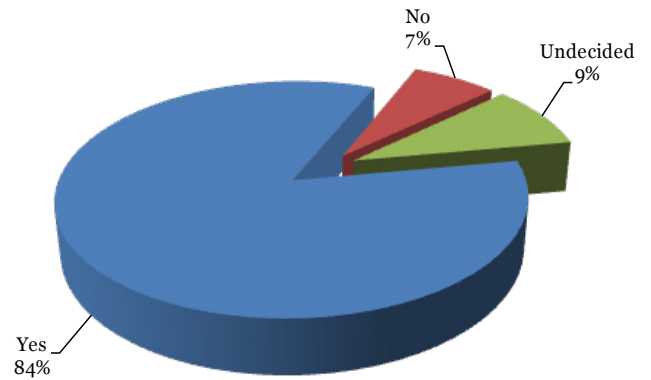

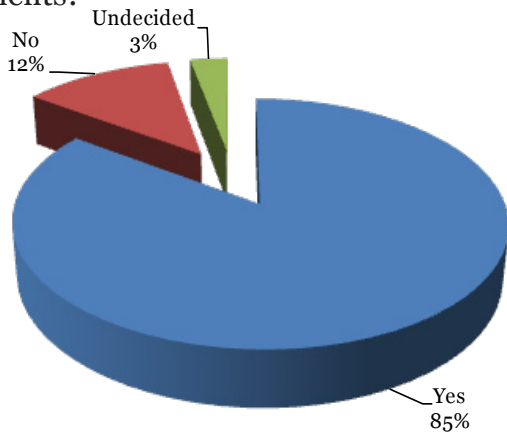

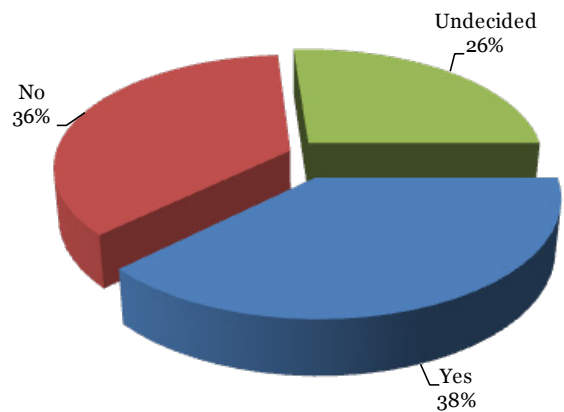
6. Do you support allowing voters to decide whether or not to eliminate their township government?



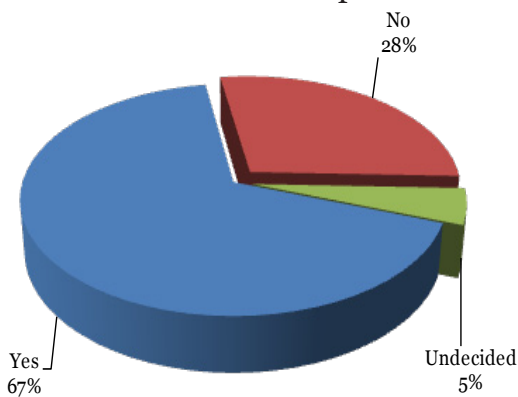
7. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?
