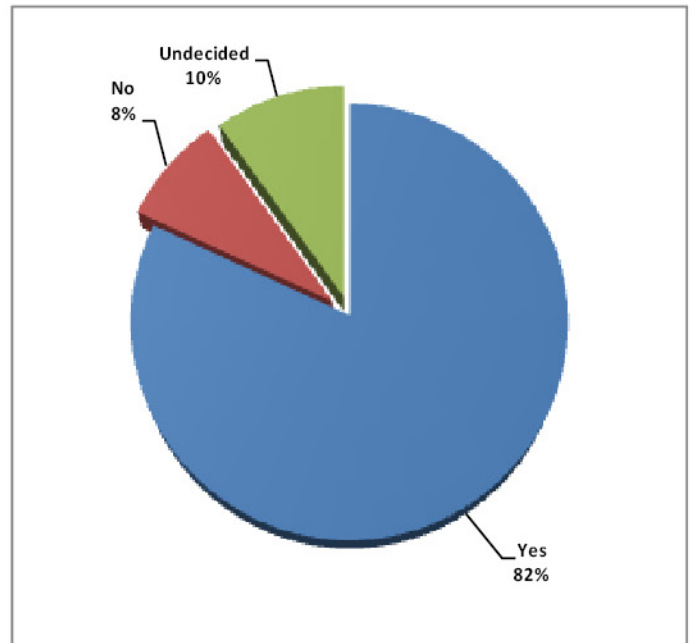
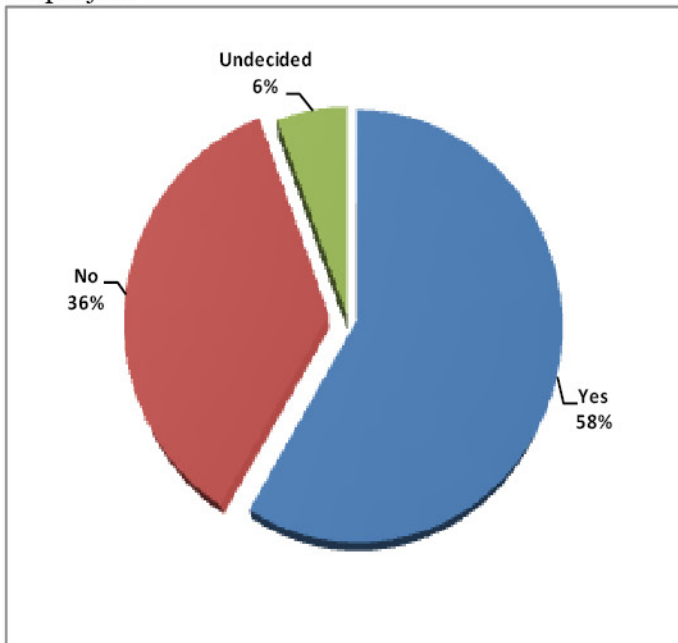
1. Am I keeping you well informed about state and local news in our district?

2. Do you believe reducing government regulation is a bigger factor in improving the economy rather than increasing government spending?



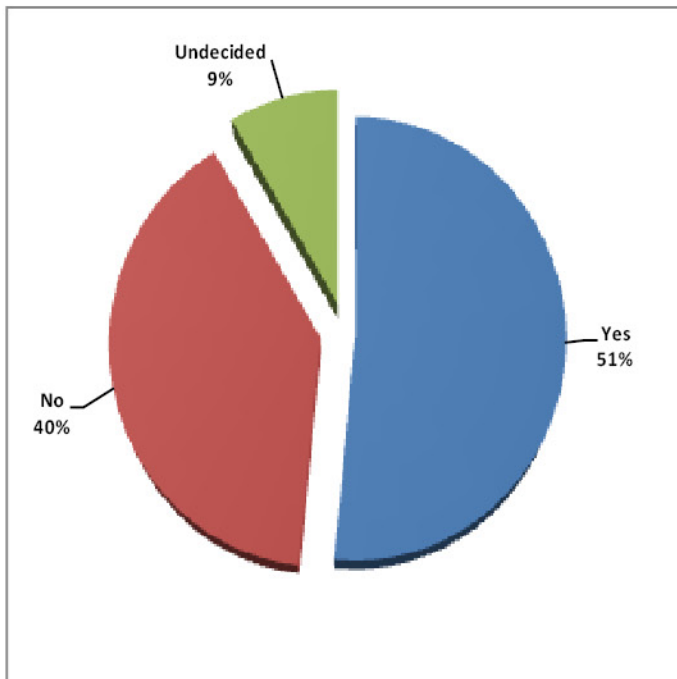
3. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?

4. Do you support prohibiting local government officials from hiring his/her family members?

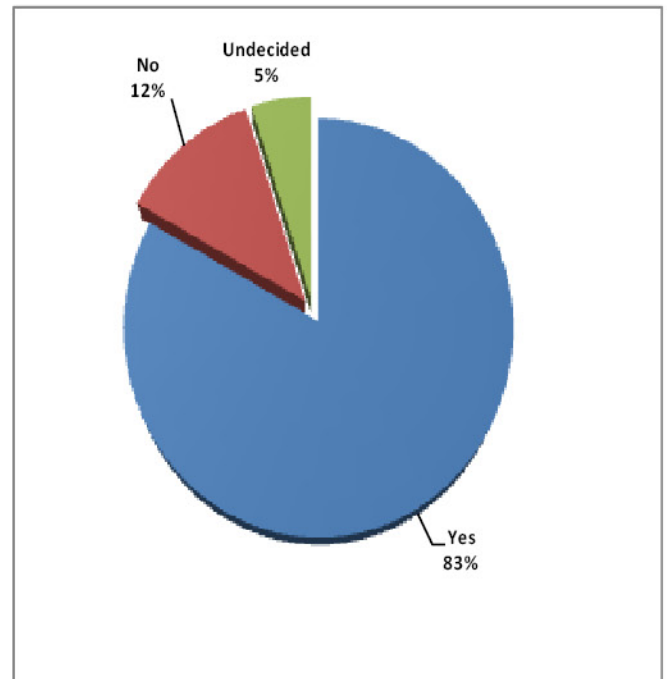

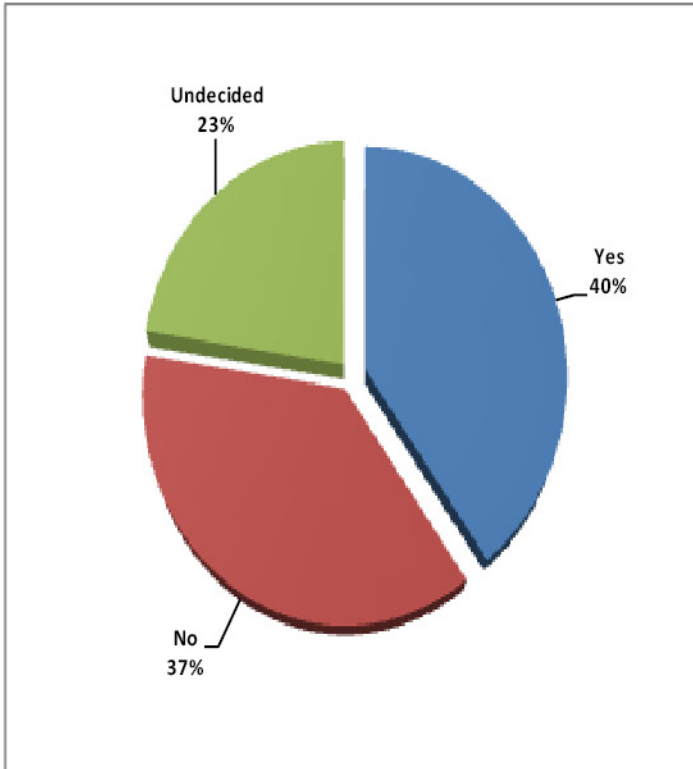
5. Do you support a statewide smoking ban?



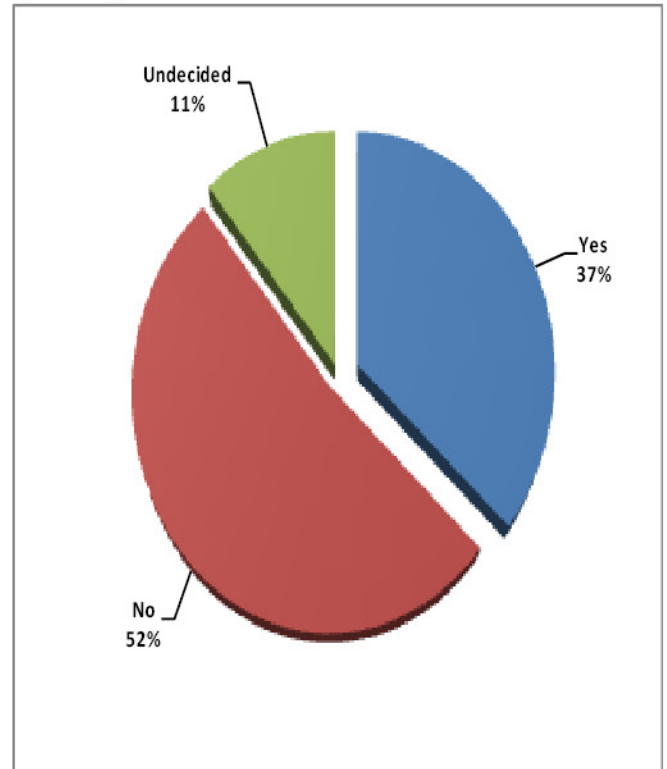
6. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits?

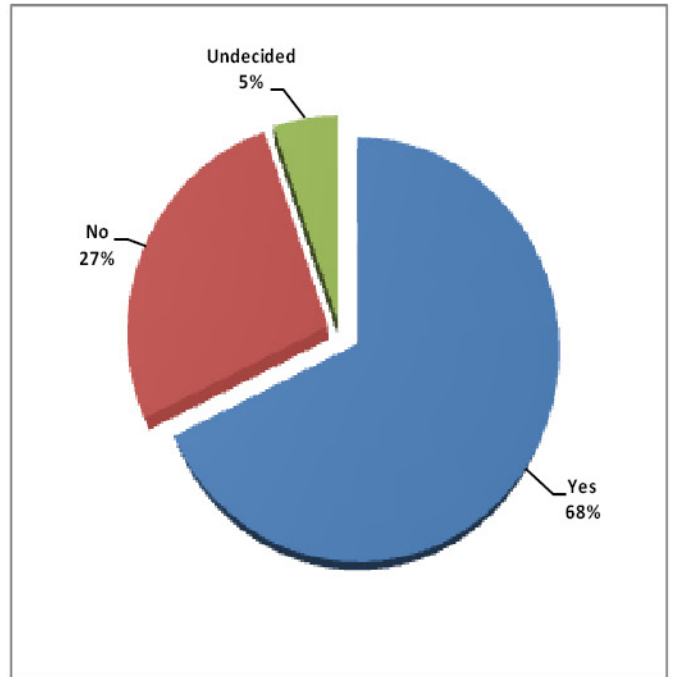
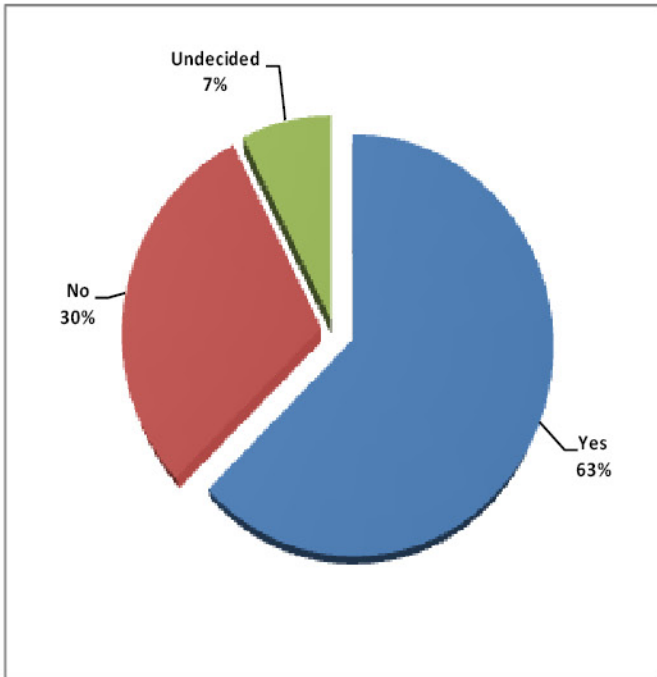
