DIGEST

Temporarily amends <u>312 IAC 18-3-18</u>, LSA Document #06-23(E), and LSA Document #06-51(E), which regulate the emerald ash borer (Agrilus planipennis) as a pest or pathogen, to provide quarantine standards with respect to the species, to quarantine any county with a township that has an infested area, and to apply the section to St. Joseph County. Effective June 12, 2006.

SECTION 1. (a) This SECTION is supplemental to 312 IAC 18-3-18(c), LSA Document #06-23(E), published at 29 IR 1957, and to LSA Document #06-51(E), published at 29 IR 2228.

- (b) Harris Township in St. Joseph County is infested with emerald ash borer.
- (c) Harris Township is regulated as an infested area and St. Joseph County is quarantined under <u>312</u> <u>IAC 18-3-18</u>, LSA Document #06-23(E), and LSA Document #06-51(E).

SECTION 2. SECTION 1 of this document expires January 1, 2007.
