## Notice of Public Hearing

Under IC 4-22-2-24, notice is hereby given that on March 1, 2007, at 10:15 a.m., at the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, Indiana Government Center-South, 402 West Washington Street, Room W064, Indianapolis, Indiana the Indiana State Board of Health Facility Administrators will hold a public hearing on proposed amendments concerning the licensure examination to address the number of examination attempts and the time frame an applicant has to pass the licensure examination.

The Indiana State Board of Health Facility Administrators has the authority to promulgate rules in accordance with IC 25-19-1-4 to establish the rules for licensure as a health facility administrator, including the number of examination attempts an applicant for licensure is allowed.
