SECTION 1. 405 IAC 2-6-2 IS ADDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 2. (a) An individual who:

(1) is:

- (A) at least eighteen (18) years of age; and
- (B) less than twenty-one (21) years of age; and
- (2) was receiving foster care when the individual became eighteen (18) years of age; and
- (3) meets the eligibility requirements in this section; is eligible for Medicaid.
- (b) An individual described in subsection (a) is eligible for Medicaid if his or her income does not exceed two hundred percent (200%) of the federal poverty guidelines for the individual's family size. Family size is determined by including the individual, his or her spouse, and children under eighteen (18)

years of age living with the individual. Income includes the income of the individual's spouse, if the

(c) Assets owned by the individual and family members are exempt.
