**Notice of Public Hearing**

Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), notice is hereby given that on July 10, 2007, at 9:00 a.m., at the Indiana Government Center-South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room 4, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Division of Family Resources will hold a public hearing on a proposed new Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) eligibility rule, [470 IAC 10.3](#).

The purpose of the proposed TANF rule under [IC 4-22-2-24\(d\)\(3\)](#) is 1) to consolidate existing scattered regulations and codify them into one unified rule; and 2) to make minor changes to eligibility requirements in order to ensure that Indiana meets the stricter TANF work participation criteria set forth by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) under the TANF Interim Final Rule, which went into effect October 1, 2006. There are no additional requirements or cost to regulated entities.
