**OVERVIEW:** Amends [410 IAC 16.2](#) to require automatic fire sprinkler systems in comprehensive care facilities and have a battery operated or hard wired smoke detector in each resident's room as required by [IC 16-28-11-5](#). Amends [410 IAC 16.2](#) to clarify license requirements for comprehensive and residential care administrators in accordance with [IC 25-19-1-5](#) regarding comprehensive care facility administrator licenses and residential care facility administrator licenses.
