Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Indiana Gaming Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends <u>68 IAC 5-1-2</u> to specify that the Indiana Gaming Commission may consider the extent to which the state of Indiana shares in the benefit of a proposed transfer of ownership as a factor in evaluating the proposed transfer and to reduce the number of copies of an application that an applicant must submit. Amends <u>68 IAC 5-2-2</u> to add references to "gambling games" as authorized in <u>IC 4-35</u> and to specify that the Indiana Gaming Commission may consider the extent to which the state of Indiana shares in the benefit of a proposed transfer of ownership as a factor in evaluating the proposed transfer. Makes numerous technical changes. Statutory authority: <u>IC 4-33-4-1</u>; <u>IC 4-33-4-2</u>; <u>IC 4-33-4-2</u>; <u>IC 4-33-4-2</u>; <u>IC 4-35-4-1</u>; <u>IC 4-35-4-2</u>; <u>IC 4-35-4-3</u>; <u>IC 4-35-4-7</u>.
