Under IC 4-22-2-24, notice is hereby given that on November 1, 2007, at 9:30 a.m. EDT, in the IURC Conference Center, Suite 220, Judicial Courtroom 224, National City Center, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission will hold a public hearing on a proposed rule (RM #07-07, LSA Document #07-514) to amend the current rule governing practice and procedure before the Commission.

Under the proposed rule, parties to a cause before the Commission will be required to file confidential documents on light green paper, a requirement mirroring Indiana Trial Rule 5, which distinguishes confidential from public documents in an effort to eliminate inadvertent disclosure of nonpublic information. While the requirement to use colored paper may marginally increase administrative expenses for parties, the proposed rule also reduces the number of copies of original documents required to be filed in causes before the Commission. The changes are expected to result in a net savings for parties.

The Commission anticipates establishing a period of time for submitting written initial comments and reply comments following the public hearing.

Copies of the proposed rule are now on file at the National City Center, 101 West Washington Street, Suite 1500 East and Legislative Services Agency, One North Capitol, Suite 325, Indianapolis, Indiana, and are open for public inspection.
