## Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule

Under IC 4-22-2-3, the Indiana State Department of Health intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Amends 410 IAC 16.2 to require automatic fire sprinkler systems in comprehensive care facilities and have a battery operated or hard-wired smoke detector in each resident's room as required by IC 16-28-11-5. Amends 410 IAC 16.2 to clarify license requirements for comprehensive and residential care administrators in accordance with IC 25-19-1-5 regarding comprehensive care facility administrator licenses and residential care facility administrator licenses. Amends the definition of children.
