## EXECUTIVE ORDER: 07-12

## FOR: PARDON

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

**WHEREAS**, ALLEN BOLLENBACHER, who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in 1984 in Jay County of Criminal Recklessness, for which he served a sentence of thirty (30) days incarceration, five-hundred (500) hours of community service and five (5) years of probation; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, who successfully completed his probation, is a married 45-year-old Indiana resident and has two (2) children; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner has numerous letters of support from family, friends, co-workers, past and present employees, and community leaders, all of whom recommend that his petition for pardon be granted; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner has been a resident of Indiana, maintained steady employment and lived an upstanding life; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner is a family man who involves himself in his community, is the Facility Manager for the Harvest Land Co-op, and this pardon is required to fulfill his duties to handle hazardous materials at Harvest Land Co-op; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has unanimously recommended that this pardon be granted.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr.,** Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a pardon to ALLEN BOLLENBACHER.
