**EXECUTIVE ORDER: 07-13**

**FOR: PARDON**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

**WHEREAS**, CARL BEAR, who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in 1963 of Burglary in Huntington County, for which he served a sentence of two (2) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner, who successfully completed his incarceration, is a married 62-year-old Arkansas resident with one (1) daughter and one (1) step-son, and three (3) grandsons; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner has numerous letters of support from family, friends, and employers, who recommend that his petition for pardon be granted; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner is a law-abiding, community-oriented, productive citizen who volunteers in his community, led an upstanding life, received certificates from numerous Arkansas ministries and departments; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has unanimously recommended that this pardon be granted.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr.**, Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a pardon to CARL BEAR.
