DIGEST

Temporarily amends <u>312 IAC 9-2-11</u>, <u>312 IAC 8-2</u>, and LSA Document #07-363(E), with respect to the taking of mute swan at state parks. Effective January 16, 2008.

SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding <u>312 IAC 9-2-11</u>, <u>312 IAC 8-2</u>, and supplemental to LSA Document #07-363(E), printed at <u>20070627-IR-312070363ERA</u>, and any other provision governing hunting a wild animal within a state park, an individual qualified under this SECTION may take a mute swan (Cygnus olor) from the following:

(1) Chain O'Lakes State Park.

(2) Pokagon State Park.

(3) Potato Creek State Park.

(b) In order to qualify under subsection (a), an individual must:

(1) be an employee of the department;

(2) possess authorization of the director or the director's designee; and

(3) comply with any terms in the written authorization.
