Notice of Public Hearing

Under [IC 4-22-2-24](#), notice is hereby given that on September 4, 2008, at 1:00 p.m., at the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room 5, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services Administration will hold a public hearing on the Division of Family Resource's (DFR) proposed food stamp rule, LSA Document #08-278.

The proposed rule under [IC 4-22-2-24\(d\)\(3\)](#) is an internal state policy change, which implements a 30 day application process for food stamp applicants. It also allows DFR to accept electronic signatures and provides more clarification of the application process. There are no additional requirements or costs to regulated entities.
