DIGEST

Adds <u>808 IAC 1-1.1-3</u> through <u>808 IAC 1-1.1-5</u> to add definitions for mixed martial arts; martial arts including jujitsu, karate, kickboxing, kung fu, and tae kwon do; and professional wrestling as required by SEA 557, P.L.112-2007. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

SECTION 1. 808 IAC 1-1.1-3 IS ADDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

808 IAC 1-1.1-3 "Martial arts" defined

Authority: <u>IC 25-9-1-4.5</u> Affected: <u>IC 35-45-18-1</u>

Sec. 3. For purposes of IC 35-45-18-1, "martial arts" means any form of:

- (1) jujitsu;
- (2) karate;
- (3) kickboxing;
- (4) kung fu;
- (5) tae kwon do;
- (6) judo; or
- (7) sumo;

or any combination of full contact martial arts, mixed martial arts, or self-defense arts, involving, but not limited to, grappling, kicking, and striking, conducted on a full contact basis where a weapon is not used.

808 IAC 1-1.1-4 "Mixed martial arts" defined

Sec. 4. For purposes of <u>IC 35-45-18-1</u>, "mixed martial arts", commonly referred to as MMA, means full unrestrained physical force in a contest that includes utilizing a combination of permitted martial arts techniques from disciplines of martial arts, including, but not limited to, grappling, kicking, and striking.

SECTION 3. 808 IAC 1-1.1-5 IS ADDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

808 IAC 1-1.1-5 "Professional wrestling" defined

Sec. 5. For purposes of <u>IC 35-45-18-1</u>, "professional wrestling" means a form of sports entertainment in which the participants display their skills in a physical struggle against each other in the ring and either the outcome may be predetermined or the participants do not necessarily strive to win, or both.
