This proposed rule updates and clarifies the procedures and the requirements of the minimum standard filing requirements rule. This rule sets a specified time frame of 10 months for completion of a rate case if the electing utility submits the required supporting documentation. This proposed rule does not impose any costs not already required under state regulations and may reduce administrative costs for the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission as well as the regulated utilities.
