**WHEREAS**, the petitioner, who successfully served her probation sentence, is now a 39-year-old woman who has become a productive member of society while raising three daughters; and has since the instant offense lived a law-abiding life; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner is very active within her church and endeavors to work with mentally challenged children; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has shown the ability to turn her life around after making a poor decision as a young woman; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has letters of support urging the Governor to grant this Pardon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has unanimously recommended to the Governor that this pardon be granted.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested** in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a Pardon to **ROBIN MITCHELL.**
