**EXECUTIVE ORDER: 08-21**

**FOR: PARDON**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

**WHEREAS, FRANCES CLARK**, who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in 1970 in Marion County of Shoplifting and Disorderly Conduct, for which paid the fine; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner, who paid the fine for the crime she committed, is now a 60-year-old woman who has been a productive member of society by volunteering within her community; serving various ministries throughout the area, and has since the instant offense lived a law-abiding and productive life; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner, who raised three law abiding children, wishes to support herself without depending on others, committed this offense over thirty-eight years ago when she was a twenty-one year old woman; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has unanimously recommended to the Governor that this pardon be granted.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr.**, Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a pardon to **FRANCES CLARK**.
