## FOR: PARDON

**WHEREAS, SARAH CRANK,** who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in 2001 in Rush County of Violation of a Custody Order, for which she served her probation without incident or violation; and

**WHEREAS**, the petitioner, who resides in Ohio, is now a 32-year-old woman who has been a productive member of society, working as a middle school teacher, is active at her church, and is a member of the local PTA; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner earned her degree in special education, and made the Dean's List while raising her four children alone; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has letters of support urging the Governor to grant this Pardon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has recommended to the Governor that this pardon be granted.
