Amends <u>812 IAC 1-1-35</u> to establish fees charged by the commission, including fees for application, issuance, and renewal of auctioneer licenses, auction house licenses, and auctioneer company licenses, examination for licensure to practice as an auctioneer, reciprocal applicants, duplicate licenses, pocket cards, certification of licensure, and licensure reinstatement. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

(b) Every auctioneer, auction house, and auction company holding a license issued by the commission shall renew their license quadrennially on or before February 28 of the fourth even-numbered year.
