# NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION Information Bulletin #54 (Second Amendment) July 1, 2009

SUBJECT: Hunting, Fishing, and Trapping License Fees

## 1. Purpose

The purpose of this information bulletin is to provide a compilation of the fees as approved by the Natural Resources Commission for hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses issued by the Department of Natural Resources. Minimum fees for hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses are established at <a href="LC 14-22-12-1">LC 14-22-12-1</a>(a); however, the Commission is authorized to set fees above the minimum in <a href="LC 14-22-12-1">LC 14-22-12-1</a>(b). License fees are established to be comparable to surrounding states and provide the DNR with the funds necessary to continue the existing programs that provide hunting, fishing, and trapping related opportunities throughout the state. This information bulletin also provides the starting and ending date, as described in <a href="LC 14-22-11-4">LC 14-22-11-4</a>, for annual hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses.
