DIGEST

Temporarily amends <u>312 IAC 9</u>, concerning the taking of raccoons, beavers, and muskrats at several state parks and reservoir properties, to allow the property manager of any state park and reservoir listed to authorize a person or persons to take any raccoon, beaver, or muskrat from that state park or reservoir. Effective January 15, 2010.

SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding <u>312 IAC 9-2-11</u>, <u>312 IAC 8-2</u>, and any other provision governing taking a wild animal within a state park or reservoir property, the property manager may authorize a person qualified under subsection (c) to take any raccoon, beaver, or muskrat from or within the state parks and reservoir properties listed in subsection (b).

(b) The state parks and reservoirs to which this document applies are as follows:

- (15) Mississinewa Reservoir Property.
- (16) Monroe Reservoir Property.
- (17) Mounds State Park.

(c) In order to qualify, a person must satisfy both of the following requirements:

(1) Possess written authorization from the property manager of the state park or reservoir property listed in subsection (b) to act under this SECTION.

(2) Possess a nuisance wild animal control permit issued under <u>312 IAC 9-10-11</u> if a raccoon, beaver, or muskrat is taken outside of the season established in the following:

- (A) For raccoon, <u>312 IAC 9-3-14</u>.
- (B) For beaver, <u>312 IAC 9-3-11</u>.

(C) For muskrat, <u>312 IAC 9-3-13</u>.
