## DIGEST

Amends 65 IAC 5-6-1 through 65 IAC 5-6-6 to reflect the current procedures, practices, and odds statements of the lottery regarding the Daily 4 draw game. Effective April 1, 2010.

SECTION 1. 65 IAC 5-6-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

## 65 IAC 5-6-1 Name

Authority: IC 4-30-3-7; IC 4-30-3-9
Affected: IC 4-30

Sec. 1. The collective name of the draw games conducted pursuant to this rule is "Daily4". As used in this rule, the term "Daily4" shall include both Daily4 - Evening and Daily4 - Midday unless context requires otherwise.

## 65 IAC 5-6-1.5 Independent games

Authority: IC 4-30-3-7; IC 4-30-3-9

Sec. 1.5. (a) Daily4 shall be conducted as two (2) separate and independent on line games designated Daily 4 - Evening and Daily4 - Midday, respectively. On-line Tickets in the Daily4 - Evening on line game are not associated with the Daily4 - Midday on line game and vice versa. The two (2) on line games shall have separate selection events, winning numbers, and prizes. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the odds, play styles, and prizes prize amounts shall be the same in all Daily 4 selection events.
(b) A multidraw ticket in the Daily4 - Evening on -line game shall be for the next Daily4 - Evening selection event(s) following the first selection event for which the ticket is valid, and a multidraw ticket in the Daily 4 Midday on line game shall be for the next Daily4 - Midday selection event(s) following the first selection event for which the ticket is valid. If the player elects to make a wager in both the Daily4 - Midday and Daily4 Evening games and requests a multidraw ticket, the multidraw option shall apply to the next consecutive selection event(s) of both the Daily4 - Evening and Daily4 - Midday games.

## 65 IAC 5-6-2 Definitions

Sec. 2. (a) The definitions in this section apply throughout this rule.
(b) "Back 3 play" means the selection of only the last three (3) numbers digits out of the four (4) digits applicable to a particular selection event for Daily4.
(c) "Box play" means a play designated as such when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing either:
(1) a wager that the four (4) numbers which may be digits selected by the player will match the winning numbers drawn by the commission in a specified selection event in any order; or
(2) a wager that the three (3) numbers digits selected by the player in a front 3 or back 3 play which may be will match the appropriate winning numbers drawn by the commission in a specified selection event in any order.
(d) "Combo play" means a play designated as such when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4-containing either:
(1) a play in which the four (4) numbers are both a wager that is split evenly between a straight play and a box play. of
(2) a front 3 or back 3 play in which the three (3) numbers are both a straight play and a box play.
(e) "Daily4 - Evening" means the Daily4 on-line game associated with selection events conducted in the evening.
(f) "Daily4 - Midday" means the Daily4 on-line game associated with selection events conducted in the afternoon.
(g) "Four way box play" means a play designated as a box play when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 eontaining four (4) numbers, three (3) of which are identicat.
(h) "Four-way combo play" means a play designated as a combo play when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing four (4) numbers, three (3) of which are identical.
(i) (g) "Front 3 play" means the selection of only the first three (3) mumbers digits out of the four (4) digits applicable to a particular selection event for Daily4.
(j) (h) "Play" means a selection of three (3) or four (4) numbers digits applicable to a particular selection event for Daily4.
(k) (i) "Quick pick" means a play randomly generated by a terminal.
(I) "Six way box play" means a play designated as a box play when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily 4 containing either:
(1) two (2) pairs of identical numbers where the four (4) numbers may be drawn in any order; of
(2) in a front 3 or back 3 play, three (3) different front or back three (3) numbers, respectively, which may be drawn in any order.
(m) "Six way combo play" means a play designated acombo play when an on-line tieket is purchased for Daily4-containing either:
(1) two (2) pairs of identical numbers; of
(2) in a front 3 or back 3 play, three (3) different numbers.
(m) (j) "Straight play" means aplay designated as such when an on-line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing either:
(1) a wager that the four (4) numbers digits selected by the player will match the winning numbers
drawn by the commission during a specified selection event in the exact order in which they will be
drawn; that the digits were selected by the player; or
(2) a wager that the three (3) numbers digits selected by the player in a front 3 or back 3 play will match the winning numbers drawn by the commission during a specified selection event in the order in which they will be drawn. exact [sic, order] that the digits were selected by the player.
(o) "Three way box play" means a play designated as such when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing a front 3 or back 3 play in which two (2) of the relevant numbers are the same and which may be drawn in any order.
(p) "Three-way combo play" means a play designated as such when an on-line ticket is purchased for Daily 4 containing a front 3 or back 3 play in which wo (2) of the relevant numbers are the same-
(q) "Twelve-way box play" means a play designated as a box play when an on-line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing four (4) numbers, two (2) of which are the same, which may be drawn in any order.
(r) "Twelve-way combo play" means a play-designated as a combo play when an on-line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing four (4) numbers, two (2) of which are the same.
(s) "Twenty four way box play" means a play designated as a box play when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing four (4) different numbers which may be drawn in any order.
( $\ddagger$ ) "Twenty four-way combo play" means a play designated as a combo play when an on line ticket is purchased for Daily4 containing four (4) different numbers.
(U) (k) "Winning numbers" means four (4) numbers, digits between and including zero (0) and nine (9), drawn by the commission in a specific order in a Daily4 - Evening or Daily4 - Midday selection event or, in the case of a front 3 or back 3 play, only the first or last three (3) numbers, digits selected, respectively. determined in a specific Daily4 Evening or Daily4 Midday-selection event.

Sec. 3. Unless otherwise requested by the purchaser, the price of an-on-line ticket containing A wager for one (1) play for Daily4 - shall Midday or Daily4 - Evening must be in increments of one dollar (\$1) The price of an on line tieket containing one (1) play for Daily4 may be increased by the purehaser in one dollar (\$1) inerements up to a maximum of and shall not exceed ten dollars (\$10).

## 65 IAC 5-6-4 Procedure for playing

Authority: IC 4-30-3-7; IC 4-30-3-9

Sec. 4. (a) An on line ticket for Daily4-shall represent one (1) play. An on line A valid ticket for Daily4 - shall Midday or Daily4 - Evening must be purchased by one (1) of the following methods:
(1) The purchaser may submit a completed play slip (if play slips are provided by from the commission which
indicates a play to or an authorized on-line retailer. who-shall generate an-on-line ticket.
(2) The purchaser may advise an autherized on line retailer of the numbers contained in the purchaser's play and the type-of play, and the on-line retailer shall generate an on line ticket.
(3) The purchaser may request a quick pick from an authorized on line retailer who shall generate an on line ticket with a random play.
A ticket may only be issued after the information and player elections required by this rule are entered into a terminal.
(b) An-on-line $\mathbf{A}$ ticket is the only valid proof of a play and the only valid receipt for claiming a prize in Daily4. A play slip shall have no pecuniary or prize value and shall not constitute evidence of purchase of an on-line a ticket or a play.
(c) Anon-line $\mathbf{A}$ ticket is effective for the selection event indicated on the on-line ticket. If a purchaser fails to specifically request Daily4 - Evening or Daily4 - Midday, the retailer may issue an on-line a ticket for the next scheduled drawing. Subject to the restrictions of 65 IAC 5-2-9, the commission may offer multidraw on-line tickets for Daily4 - Evening or Daily4 - Midday selection events which are effective for up to twenty-eight (28) consecutive selection events. Daily4 multidraw on line tickets are limited to the on line game for which they were purchased and cannot include plays that alternate between unless the player elects to apply multidraw to both the Daily4 - Evening and Daily4 - Midday selection events.
(d) Sales of en line tickets for Daily4 selection events shall be suspended prior to the time of the associated selection event at a time determined by the director.
(e) Sales of en-line tickets containing a particular play shall be suspended if the total liability of the commission for winning on-line tickets containing that play would exceed an amount established by the director. No person shall be entitled to purchase an [sic, a] en line ticket containing any particular play if such play has been suspended, and neither the commission, the director, nor any employee of the commission shall be liable for the inability of any person to purchase anon-line a ticket containing a particular play.
(f) On-line Entry coupons may be generated by terminals for certain purchases of en-line tickets for Daily4.

Sec. 5. (a) Selection events for determination of winning numbers in Daily4 - Evening shall be held each day. in accordance with 65 IAC $5-3-7$ at a time to be determined by the director. Selection events for determination of winning numbers in Daily4 - Midday shall be held on Monday through Saturday afternoons.
(b) Each selection event in a Daily4 game shall:
(1) be conducted:
(A) in accordance with 65 IAC 5-3-7; and
(B) at a time designated to be determined by the director;
(2) determine four (4) winning numbers between and including zero (0) and nine (9); and
(3) determine the order that the winning numbers were selected.

(A) All four (4) digits are unique (commonly referred to as a twenty-four way box play or, for example, " $3-4-5-7$ ") wins a prize of two hundred dollars (\$200).
(d) Each owner of a valid on line ticket for a Daily4 selection event on which the four (4) numbers in a one dollar (\$1) twelve way box play applicable to that selection event match the four (4) winning numbers in any order
(B) Three (3) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating (commonly referred to as a twelve way box play or, for example, " $3-4-5-5$ ") wins a prize of four hundred dollars (\$400).

(3) Combo play applicable to that selection event match matches the four (4) winning numbers in any order and:
(A) All four (4) digits are unique (commonly referred to as a twenty-four way box match only combo or, for example, " $3-4-5-7$ ") wins a prize of one hundred dollars (\$100).
(h) Each owner of a valid on-line ticket for a Daily4-selection ovent on which the four (4) numbers in a one dollar (\$1) twelve way combo play applicable to that selection ovent mateh the four (4) winning numbers in any order
(B) Three (3) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating (commonly referred to as a twelve-way box
match only combo or, for example, " $3-4-5-5$ ") wins a prize of two hundred dollars (\$200).
(i) Each owner of a valid on line ticket for a Daily4-selection event on which the four (4) numbers in a one dollar (\$1) six way combo play applicable to that selection event match the four (4) winning numbers in any order
(C) Includes two (2) pairs of digits, for example, "3-3-5-5", wins a prize of four hundred dollars (\$400).

(k) Each owner of a valid on-line ticket for a Daily4-selection event on which the four (4) numbers in a one dollar (\$1) twonty-four way combo play applicable to that selection event mateh the four (4) winning numbers and are in the same-order as the four (4) winning numbers
(4) Combo play that matches the four (4) winning numbers in exact order and:
(A) All four (4) digits are unique, for example, "3-4-5-7", wins a prize of two thousand six hundred dollars $(\$ 2,600)$.
(1) Each owner of a valid on line ticket for a Daily4-selection event on which the four (4) numbers in a one dollar (\$1) twelve way combo play applicable to that selection event match the four (4) winning numbers and are in the same order as the four (4) winning numbers

Sec. 6. (a) The odds of winning a prize of five thousand dollars $(\$ 5,000)$ in a Daily4 selection event with a straight play are approximately one (1) in ten thousand $(10,000)$.
(b) The odds of winning a prize of two hundred dollars (\$200) in a Daily4 selection event with a wenty four way box play, in which all four (4) digits are unique (commonly referred to as a twenty-four way box play or, for example, "3-4-5-7"), are approximately hundred seventeen (417).
(c) The odds of winning a prize of four hundred dollars (\$400) in a Daily4 selection event with a box play, in which three (3) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating (commonly referred to as a twelve way box play or, for example, "3-4-5-5"), are approximately (12) in ten thousand(10,000). one (1) in eight hundred thirty-three (833).
(d) The odds of winning a prize of eight hundred dollars (\$800) in a Daily4 selection event with a six-way box play, in which two (2) digits are unique with both repeating, for example, "3-5-3-5", are approximately six (6) in ten thousand (10,000). one (1) in one thousand six hundred sixty-seven $(1,667)$.
(e) The odds of winning a prize of one thousand two hundred dollars $(\$ 1,200)$ in a Daily4 selection event with a four-way box play, in which two (2) digits are unique with one (1) of the digits repeating twice, for example, " $3-5-5-5$ ", are approximately four (4) one (1) in ten two thousand $(10,000)$. five hundred $(2,500)$.
(f) The odds of winning a prize of one hundred dollars (\$100) in a Daily4 selection event with a enedollar (\$1) (4) digits are unique, for example, "3-4-5-7", and match in any order, are approximately (435).
(g) The odds of winning a prize of two hundred dollars (\$200) in a Daily4 selection event with a ene dollar (\$1) welve-way combo play, in which three (3) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating, for example, "3-4 $-5-5$ ", and match in any order, are approximately twelve (12) in ten thousand (10,000). one (1) in nine hundred nine (909).
(h) The odds of winning a prize of four hundred dollars (\$400) in a Daily4 selection event with a ene-dollar (\$1) six-way combo play, in which two (2) digits are unique with both repeating, for example, "3-5-3-5", and match in any order, are approximately six (6) one (1) in ten two thousand $(10,000)(2,000)$.
(i) The odds of winning a prize of six hundred dollars (\$600) in a Daily4 selection event with a one-dollar (\$1) fourway combo play, in which two (2) digits are unique with one (1) of the digits repeating twice, for example, "3-5-5-5", and match in any order, are approximately four (4) one (1) in ten three thousand $(10,000)$. three hundred thirty-three (3,333).
(j) The odds of winning a prize of two thousand six hundred dollars $(\$ 2,600)$ in a Daily4 selection event with a ene dollar (\$1) twenty four way combo play, in which all four (4) digits are unique, for example, "3-4-57', and match in exact order, are approximately one (1) in ten thousand $(10,000)$.
(k) The odds of winning a prize of two thousand seven hundred dollars $(\$ 2,700)$ in a Daily4 selection event with a ene dellar (\$1) twelve way combo play, in which three (3) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating, for example, " $3-4-5-5$ ", and match in exact order, are approximately one (1) in ten thousand $(10,000)$.

(p) The odds of winning a prize of one hundred sixty dollars (\$160) in a Daily 4 selection event with a front 3 or back 3 box play, in which two (2) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating, for example, " 3 $-5-3^{\prime \prime}$, and match in any order, are approximately thre (3) in one thousand (1,000). one (1) in three hundred thirty-three (333).
(q) The odds of winning a prize of forty dollars (\$40) in a Daily4 selection event with a ene dollar (\$1) front 3 or back 3 six-way combo play, in which all three (3) numbers are unique, for example, "3-5-8", and match in any order, are approximately six (6) in one thousand (1,000). one (1) in two hundred (200).
(r) The odds of winning a prize of eighty dollars (\$80) in a Daily4 selection event with a (\$1) front 3 or back 3 combo play, in which two (2) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating, for example, "3-3-5", and match in any order, are approximately (hree (3) (1) in five hundred (500).
(s) The odds of winning a prize of two hundred ninety dollars (\$290) in a Daily4 selection event with a ene dollar (\$1) front 3 or back 3 six combo play, in which all three (3) numbers are unique, for example, " 3 -$5-8$ ", and match in exact order, are approximately one (1) in one thousand $(1,000)$.
(t) The odds of winning a prize of three hundred thirty dollars (\$330) in a Daily4 selection event with a ene doltar (\$1) front 3 or back 3 three way combo play, in which two (2) digits are unique with one (1) digit repeating, for example, "3-3-5" and match in exact order, are approximately one (1) in one thousand $(1,000)$.
