## Notice of Public Hearing

Under <u>IC 4-22-2-24</u>, notice is hereby given that on June 15, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. at the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room 2, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services will hold a public hearing regarding proposed amendments to <u>405 IAC 5-</u> <u>9-1</u> and <u>405 IAC 5-25-2</u> to correct conflicting IAC language regarding the number of allowable office visits per calendar year and to conform all IAC references to the number of allowable office visits to 30 per calendar year, per recipient, per provider without prior authorization.

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration, Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning has authority to adopt this rule under <u>IC 12-8-6-10</u>. Indiana Medicaid providers need clear expectations of what services require prior authorization and which do not for proper reimbursement. This proposed rule change will set clear expectations for prior authorization. The proposed rule is not expected to result in an increase of state expenditures. Furthermore, this rule will not have an impact on small businesses, as defined in <u>IC 4-22-2.1-4</u>.
