DIGEST

Temporarily amends <u>326 IAC 1-4</u> to include the federal redesignations for Lake and Porter counties and Lawrenceburg Township, Dearborn County to attainment for the eight-hour ozone standard. Statutory authority: <u>IC 4-22-2-37.1</u>(a)(13). Effective June 4, 2010.

SECTION 1. The following attainment status designations are applicable to Dearborn County:
