# DIGEST

Adds <u>874 IAC 2</u> concerning private investigators and security guards to establish fees and implement the requirements of SEA 506, P.L.185-2007. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

SECTION 1. 874 IAC 2 IS ADDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

### **ARTICLE 2. PRIVATE INVESTIGATOR FIRMS AND SECURITY GUARD AGENCIES**

Rule 1. General Provisions

874 IAC 2-1-1 Fees

Authority: <u>IC 25-1-8-2;</u> <u>IC 25-30</u> Affected: <u>IC 25-30</u>

Sec. 1. (a) The application/issuance fee for a license as a private investigator firm shall be as follows: (1) Three hundred dollars (\$300) if the application is filed one (1) year or more from the date of the next quadrennial renewal expiration date.

(2) One hundred fifty dollars (\$150) if the application is filed less than one (1) year from the date of the next quadrennial renewal expiration date.

(b) The application/issuance fee for a license as a security guard agency shall be as follows:

(1) Three hundred dollars (\$300) if the application is filed one (1) year or more from the date of the next quadrennial renewal expiration date.

(2) One hundred fifty dollars (\$150) if the application is filed less than one (1) year from the date of the next quadrennial renewal expiration date.

(c) The quadrennial renewal fee for a license as a private investigator firm shall be three hundred dollars (\$300).

(d) The quadrennial renewal fee for a license as a security guard agency shall be three hundred dollars (\$300).
