**TITLE 312 NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION**

**Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule**

LSA Document #10-657

Under [IC 4-22-2-23](#), the Natural Resources Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

**OVERVIEW:** Amends [312 IAC 9-7-3](#) by changing the size of catfish that can be taken in a river or stream other than the Ohio River. Amends [312 IAC 9-7-16](#) by establishing size and bag limits for catfish taken from the Ohio River. Amends [312 IAC 9-8-2](#) and [312 IAC 9-8-6](#) governing commercial fishing on the Ohio River and all inland waters by establishing size and bag limits for catfish. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.
