Under <u>IC 4-22-2-23</u>, the Natural Resources Commission intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends <u>312 IAC 9-1-7</u> governing the definition of the term "falconry". Adds <u>312 IAC 9-10-13.1</u> governing falconry licenses and includes the taking, possessing, caring for, training, and transporting of falconry raptors and the hunting of wild game with raptors. Repeals <u>312 IAC 9-10-13</u>. Effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.
