The proposed rule amendments will impose costs only on certified persons who have delayed the submission of their recertification documentation. The purpose of the rule is to allow those persons to become recertified within a specified delayed period of time as an alternative to applying for a variance from the Commission. The Emergency Medical Services Commission has authority to adopt this rule under <u>IC 16-31-2-7</u>.
