Temporarily amends [312 IAC 9-7-6](#) by removing the restrictions for taking black bass at J. C. Murphey Lake at Willow Slough Fish and Wildlife Area in Newton County. Temporarily amends [312 IAC 9-7-14](#) by removing the restrictions for taking bluegill, redear sunfish, and crappie at J. C. Murphey Lake at Willow Slough Fish and Wildlife Area in Newton County. SECTION 1. (a) This SECTION supersedes [312 IAC 9-7-6\(i\)](#).

(b) An individual must not take or possess more than two (2) largemouth bass per day, and an individual must not take or possess a largemouth bass unless the largemouth bass is at least eighteen (18) inches long from the following designated waters:

- (1) Tri-County State Fish and Wildlife Area.
- (2) Robinson Lake in Whitley County and Kosciusko County.
- (3) Ball Lake in Steuben County.
- (4) Gibson Lake in Gibson County.
- (5) Loon Pit at Blue Grass Fish and Wildlife Area in Warrick County.
- (6) Bluegrass Pit at Blue Grass Fish and Wildlife Area in Warrick County.

SECTION 2. (a) This SECTION supersedes [312 IAC 9-7-14](#).

(b) There is no bag limit, possession limit, or size limit for the following:

- (1) Alewife.
- (2) American eel.
- (3) Bluegill.
- (4) Bowfin.
- (5) Buffalo.
- (6) Bullhead.
- (7) Carp.
- (8) Chain pickerel.
- (9) Chub.
- (10) Cisco.
- (11) Gar.
- (12) Gizzard shad.
- (13) Lake herring.
- (14) Lake whitefish.
- (15) Shad.
- (16) Smelt.
- (17) Sucker.
- (18) Yellow bass.
