OVERVIEW: Repeals <u>405 IAC 5-31-8</u>, which provides for Medicaid reimbursement to nursing facility providers for reserving beds for Medicaid recipients at one-half the per diem rate when the Medicaid recipient is not present in the facility due to a hospital stay or leave of absence for therapeutic reasons. Statutory authority: <u>IC</u> <u>12-8-6-5</u>; <u>IC 12-15-1-10</u>; <u>IC 12-15-21-2</u>.
