Under <u>IC 4-22-2-24</u>, notice is hereby given that on April 12, 2011, at 10:30 a.m., at the Indiana Gaming Commission, 101 West Washington Street, Suite 1600-East Tower, Executive Conference Room, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Indiana Gaming Commission will hold a public hearing on a new proposed rule adding <u>68 IAC 15-15</u> concerning delinquent child support withholding from casino winnings.

The Indiana Gaming Commission has the authority to promulgate rules in accordance with the requirements of IC 4-33 and IC 4-35. It is estimated that zero small businesses in the gaming industry would be affected by this rule. The proposed rule may increase costs for casino companies to comply with the child support withholding requirements. The proposed rule may also increase costs for casino companies as they will need to update their internal procedures or controls to comply with the new rules. These costs are associated with the minimal standards necessary to ensure that delinquent child support collections from winnings are conducted in accordance with Indiana law. The Commission has relied on internal analysis and consultation with the Department of Child Services regarding the imposition of costs.
