Title: Interpretation of IC 22-12-1-5 and 675 IAC 12-1.1-4(g)

Purpose: To clarify that one or two family dwellings used for seasonal accommodation, including structures sometimes known as "tourist cabins", are Class 2 structures.

Interpretation: The Building Law Compliance Officer interprets <u>IC 22-12-1-5</u>, the definition of "Class 2 structure", and <u>675 IAC 12-1.1-4(g)</u> to include one or two family dwellings that are used for seasonal accommodation, including those sometimes known as "tourist cabins". As Class 2 structures, such structures are regulated under the applicable Indiana Residential Code (<u>675 IAC 14</u>).
