Under <u>IC 4-22-2-23</u>, the Office of the Secretary of Family and Social Services intends to adopt a rule concerning the following:

OVERVIEW: Amends <u>405 IAC 5-2</u> to include applicable school-based services definitions. Amends <u>405 IAC</u> <u>5-3-12</u> to include additional exceptions for certain school-based services to the prior authorization requirements. Amends <u>405 IAC 5-4-2</u> to allow for school corporations to provide transportation services for students with individualized education programs. Amends <u>405 IAC 5-22-2</u> to allow and set forth requirements for Medicaid reimbursement of nursing services provided by a public school corporation for students with individualized education programs. Adds <u>405 IAC 5-30-11</u> to set forth requirements for Medicaid reimbursement of transportation services provided by a public school corporation.
