Under <u>IC 4-22-2-24</u>, notice is hereby given that on June 21, 2012, at 9:00 a.m., at the Indiana Department of Education Riley Room, 151 West Ohio Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Indiana State Board of Education will hold a public hearing on proposed changes to Title 511 of the Indiana Administrative Code.

The proposed rule adds <u>511 IAC 10.1</u> to provide definitions for teacher licensure and certification, adds <u>511 IAC 13</u> to establish standards for accreditation of teacher preparation programs, adds <u>511 IAC 14</u> to establish standards for probationary and professional practitioner licenses and license renewal, adds <u>511 IAC 15</u> to establish school settings and content areas for licensure, adds <u>511 IAC 16</u> to establish procedures for recognition of licenses received under prior rules, procedure and requirements for licensure and permit applications, and procedure for licensure revocation, adds <u>511 IAC 17</u> to establish requirements and procedures for workplace specialist licenses, adds <u>511 IAC 18</u> to establish requirements and procedures for educational interpreters permit, and adds <u>511 IAC 19</u> to establish requirements and procedures for school psychologists. The proposed rule would not impose requirements or costs under <u>IC 4-22-2-24(d)(3)</u>.
