Temporarily amends <u>312 IAC 8-2</u> and <u>312 IAC 9-2-11</u> with respect to the taking of mute swan at state parks. Statutory authority: <u>IC 4-22-2-37.1</u>; <u>IC 14-10-2-5</u>; <u>IC 14-22-2-6</u>. Effective April 18, 2013.

SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding 312 IAC 9-2-11, 312 IAC 8-2, and any other provision governing hunting a wild animal within a state park, an individual qualified under this SECTION may take a mute swan (Cygnus olor) from the following:

- (1) Chain O'Lakes State Park.
- (2) Pokagon State Park.
- (3) Potato Creek State Park.
- (4) Shakamak State Park.
- (5) Summit Lake State Park.
- (b) In order to qualify under subsection (a), an individual must:
- (1) be an employee of the department;
- (2) possess authorization of the director or the director's designee; and
- (3) comply with any terms in the written authorization.
