

## TITLE 326 AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DIVISION

**Emergency Rule**  
LSA Document #13-337(E)

DIGEST

Temporarily amends [326 IAC 1-4](#) to add the federal designations for Lawrenceburg Township in Dearborn County, Lake County, and Porter County to nonattainment of the 2008 8-hour ozone standard and for the remainder of Dearborn County to unclassifiable or attainment of the 2008 8-hour ozone standard and to add the federal designations for parts of Dearborn County, Gibson County, Pike County, and Spencer County to unclassifiable or attainment of the annual PM<sub>2.5</sub> standard. Statutory authority: [IC 13-14-8-1](#). *NOTE: The original emergency document, LSA Document #13-161(E), posted at [20130417-IR-326130161ERA](#), effective April 16, 2013, expired July 15, 2013. Effective July 17, 2013.*

NO <sub>2</sub>	Cannot be classified or better than national standards.
Pb	Unclassifiable or attainment effective December 31, 2011.
<sup>1</sup> Nonattainment Severe 17 effective November 15, 1990, for the Chicago-Gary-Lake County area for the 1-hour ozone standard, which was revoked effective June 15, 2005.

PM <sub>10</sub>	Unclassifiable effective November 15, 1990.
NO <sub>2</sub>	Cannot be classified or better than national standards.
Pb	Unclassifiable or attainment effective December 31, 2011.

The remainder of Porter County is better than national standards.
CO	Unclassifiable or attainment effective November 15, 1990.
