**WHEREAS**, the petitioner is now 39 years old, has no criminal record but for this conviction, has been employed since the conviction, and has earned associate and bachelor's degrees and a graduate certificate; and

**WHEREAS**, the Indiana Parole Board, after careful investigation, review and examination of the facts with respect to petitioner in this matter has unanimously recommended that the Governor pardon petitioner.
